 paid and paid or Ordained to be paid in Convenient time after my
 decease by my Executors hereafter named. ^{Item} I Give and Devise unto
 Hannah Symonds and her heirs who she is Constituted make and Ordain
 the only & sole Heirs of this my last Will and Testament, all my whole
 Estate both Real and Personal viz^t all my Lands Messuages and Tenements
 together with the free ty to be possessed and enjoyed within this Province or beyond
 the same within any of his Majesty's Dominions with all my Moveable
 household Goods and Chattels, Plate Jewels, & wearing Apparel
 I do hereby utterly disallow, Revoke, Disannul, all and every other
 Wills, Testaments, Gifts, Legacies and Bequests and Executors by me, or
