 in manner and Form following that is to say First my Will  
 is that all my Just Debts and funeral Charges be well and  
 Truly paid Discharged and Satisfied by my Executrices and  
 Executor hereinafter named Also I give & Devise all my Lot  
 and Mesuage in Charlestown wherein I now live with the  
 Shop and appurtenances thereto belonging unto my wife  
 Eleanor during the Term of her natural Life and after her  
 Death I give and Devise the same to be sold by my Execut  
 & Executor and the monies arising therefrom, I give & bequeath  
 to my Son Thomas and my Daughter Anna Maria to be  
 Divided between them share and share alike & in case of  
 the Death of one of them before the age of twenty one years  
 I give and bequeath the Share of such Child dying to the  
 Survivor & in case both my said Children dye before their  
 respective ages of twenty one years I give and bequeath  
 what is herein before given unto them to Gilson Clap to be  
 Delivered to him at the age of Twenty one years And in  
 case of the said Gilson's Death before he arrives at the  
 age of Twenty one years I give and bequeath the same  
 to his Mother M<sup>rs</sup> Sarah Clap her Executors Adminors

And assigns for ever Also I give & Devise all my Plantation  
 containing Five hundred Acres of Land with the appurtenances  
 Situate at the Salt Hatches in the said Province to my Son  
 Thomas his heirs and assigns for ever Also I give and Devise  
 Part of a Town Lot lately bought of Job Rothmaler & adjoining  
 to David Christians Lot containing thirty Feet in Front and one  
 hundred feet in Depth to my Executrices & Executor to be by  
 them reconveyed to the said Job Rothmaler for and in Con-  
 sideration of four hundred and eighty Pounds now due by  
 me to him And in case the said Job Rothmaler will not  
 accept of the said Lot for the said Consideration I give and  
 Devise the same to be sold by my said Executrices & Executor  
 and the monies therefrom arising to be applied towards the  
 Discharging the said Job Rothmaler's Debt Also I give and  
 Bequeath the use of my Negro Man named Lister and of all  
 my Shop Tools and other Instruments of my Trade to my said  
 Wife until my said Son Thomas shall arrive at the age of  
 Twenty One years and after his arriving at such age I give  
 and bequeath the said Negro Man Shop Tools & Instruments to  
 of Trade to my said Son his Executors Administrators & assigns  
 Also I give and bequeath the use of my Negro Woman named  
 Joan to my said Wife until my Daughter Anna Maria shall  
 arrive at the age of Twenty one years or Day of Marriage &  
 after her arriving to such age or Day of Marriage I give &  
 Bequeath the said Negro Woman to my said Daughter her  
 Executors Administrators and assigns Also I give and

Devise all the rest of my Estate real and Personal to my  
said Elife her heirs Executors Administrators & Assigns  
for ever the better to Enable her to maintain her self and  
Family & to bring up and Educate my said Children Lastly  
I constitute Nominate and Appoint my said Elife Eleanor  
and M<sup>rs</sup> Sarah Clap Executors and Doctor John Moultrie  
Executor of this my Last Will and Testament And I do  
hereby annul and make Void all former & other Wills by  
me heretofore made and do Pronounce Publish & Declare  
this only to be my Last Will and Testament In  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and Seal this twenty eight Day of April in the year of our  
Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Nine.
