Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Brother Benjamin Cox Seven hundred pounds Currency of this Province as soon as it can be made off my Plantation without Selling Slaves and after my Just Debts are duly paid.

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Brother Robert Cox Seven hundred Pounds Currency of this Province as soon as it can be made off my Plantation without Selling of Slaves and after my Just debts are duly paid.

Item I give and bequeath unto a Charity School if Erected in Jacksons Town and if found by my Executors to be of a good foundation for the Poor Five hundred pounds Currency of this Province

Item my Will is that my hereafter named Executors shall use any part of my land or sell any part of my Personal Estate Excepting Slaves to pay my just Debts and Legacies and as soon as they are paid then my whole personal Estate that is remaining I do desire should be equally divided between my two Nephews John North & Edward North.

Item I do hereby nominate appoint & constitute my well beloved friend Joseph Andrews and my well John Burnham and my well beloved friend Joseph Barber to be my lawful Executors to this my Last Will and Testament and for their trouble for fulfilling this my Last Will & Testament I do will and bequeath Each one of them One hundred pounds Currency apiece revoking and disanulling all former Wills by me made ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. Witness my hand and Seal this Eighth day of October and in the fifteenth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second of Great Britain France and Ireland King defender of the faith A.D. 1742.

Alexander Frisel of the Parish of Christ Church in the Province of South Carolina Planter being of sound mind and perfect memory praised be Almighty God for the same but considering the uncertainty of this Mortal life and the certainty of death do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say)

First and principally recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God hoping to be saved thro the Merits and Intercession of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and my Body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named and as for my Temporal Estate when with it has pleased God to bless me with I give and dispose thereof in manner and form following (that is to say)

Imprimis

I give unto my beloved Wife Mary Frisel as long as she remains my Widow her living and maintenance in the Plantation I now live on

Item

I give devise and bequeath unto my loving Children Nathaniel Frisel Ely Frisel Alexander Frisel and William Frisel all my Real Estate of what kind or nature so ever to them my said Sons Nathaniel ~~and~~ Ely Alexander and William their heirs and Assigns forever to be Equally parted and divided between them Share & Share alike

Item

I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary Frisel which is in lieu of her thirds and right of Dower my Negro Wench named Judith and one Feather bed with its furniture.

Item

I do give and bequeath all my goods and Chattels and personal Estate of what kind so ever (my funeral Expences and debts being first discharged) to my five Children to be divided amongst them in even and Equall portions by name Nathaniel Ely Alexander William and my daughter Mary to them their heirs and Assigns forever.

Item

I do give unto my sister Mary Frisel her living and Maintenance at the Discretion of my Executors in the Plantation I now live on during her natural life.

Item

I do give my Brother Samuel McKnight and Martha his Wife one year's Diet & Lodging in the Plantation I now live on And I do hereby nominate & Appoint my beloved Wife Mary Frisel Executrix and my friends Anthony Borneau junr Lewis Morison junr & Elias Troussin Executors of this my last Will & Testament and I do hereby revoke and make void all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore made In Witness whereof I have Signed Sealed published and declared these presents to be and contain my only last Will & Testament this ninth day of March Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty nine.

I give unto my beloved Wife Hester Dubose her heirs and Assigns forever one Negro man named Dublin one Negro wench named Sary and one Negro Child named Ammaritt One good Feather bed one Matlas & Straw bed Bolster Pillow and two Blankets and two pair of Sheets all my Poultry and a large Sett of Silver Tea spoons a riding horse named Glove one breeding mare and one half part of my Star of hogg six cows six geese.

Item

I give unto my Son Isaac Dubose his heirs or Assigns forever One Tract of land on the North side of Santee River containing one hundred and twenty and two Acres of land and
