To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting.

Whereas Benjamin Stocks and Thomas Stocks infant Children of
Jonathan Stocks Esq^r of this Province Deceased have this Day
made humble application to me That George Page now of this
Province planter who hath also desired that he may take into
his care the Charge and Management of the said infant Children
and their Estate and may be appointed their Guardian, Therefore
for the better Securing of their Estate and for the more careful main-
tenance and Education of the said infant Children out of the confidence
I repose in the wisdom and Integrity of the said George Page do hereby
commit the tuition Guardianship and Education of the said infant
Children to the said George Page according to their Desire
hereby charging him that he do maintain them in meat, Drink,
Washing, Rodding, Clothing, and such good Education as may be
fitting according to the Circumstances and Interest of the said
infant Children during their minority, and that the said

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George Page do enquire into, and take care and charge of their Estate both real and personal, and do all other things as a Guardian by Law may do: and a true and faithful account thereof, and what Estate of the said Benjamin Stocks shall come to his hands to render when they shall be hereto required by such Guardian as shall be chosen by the said infant Children when they shall attain to the age of one and twenty years.

To Rebecca Didcott Widow
Whereas the Last Will and Testament of Abraham Didcott late of this Province Deceased was on the Ninth Day of September 1740 by Virtue of a Quodam Potestatem from me to Wm Freeman Esq^r proved & allowed of before the said Wm Freeman A Copy of which to these presents is annexed, The Deceased having whilst he lived & at the Time of his Death divers goods Rights & Credits whereof the power of Granting the admion. of all and singular the goods Rights & Credits of the said Deceased & the adding the accounts Calculations & reckonings of the s^d admion. & a final Dismission from the same to me is manifestly known to Belong. And whereas James Cochran Esq^r named whole & sole Executor of the s^d last will & Testament is since departed this life having first made his Last Will & Testament thereby Constituting & Appointing Samuel Perronneau Richard Ash & Hugh Bryan Executors thereof who have refused to take upon them the Execution of the Last Will & Testament of Abraham Didcott as Executors to the Last Will & Testament of the said James Cochran and I thereby Desiring that the s^d goods Rights & Credits which were of the said Abraham Didcott Deceased may be Well & Truly administered Converted & Disposed of. Do therefore grant unto you the said Rebecca Didcott (in whose Fidelity in this behalf I very much Confide) Full power by the Tenor of these presents to administer the goods Rights & Credits of the said Deceased with his last Will & Testament any
