fied Mary Brozett Executrix to the same this 17th day of November 1743.

ter and my Daughter Siddy and my Son Edward and my Daught^r Elizabeth my Effects and Substance
what will be remaining after my Debts are all paid I likewise constitute make and ordain for my
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament Mr Abram Naught and Mr Jacob Naught and I do hereby utter-
ly disallow revoke and Disannul all and every former Testaments Wills Legacies Executors by me in any
ways before Named confirming this to be my Last Will & Testam^t and no other In Witness Whereof I have here-
unto set my hand and seal this Nineteenth day of October One thousand seven hundred forty three
