

one Tract of Land containing two hundred ten acres on the north side of Santee River being part of a tract of land containing four hundred and twenty acres Also Two hundred and fifty Acres of land which is part of a tract containing five hundred and fifty Acres on the North side of Santee River I give also unto my said Son Isaac Dubose the Choicest of the Negro men belonging to me also a set of Silver Tasspowns marked with **ED** One flather bed One Matlase and Strawbed & Bedding Outlase Pistols houlsters laps Saddle and bridle houstens the Choise of my Guns and Bouteouch box one Bay horse named Cherryree and one Mare and Colt from my Stock of mares.

Item I give unto my son Joshua Dubose his heirs or Assigns forever one tract of land on the north side of Santee River and one tract of Land containing two hundred and ten acres of Land being part of a Tract of Land which contains four hundred & twenty Acres and two hundred and fifty Acres of Land being part of a Tract of Land which contains five hundred Acres on the north side of Santee River.

Item I give unto my son Jonathan Dubose his heirs or Assigns forever Two hundred Seventy and five Acres of Land on the South side of Santee River being part of a tract of land containing five hundred and fifty Acres and One tract of land containing One hundred thirty and four acres on the Southside of Santee River Also One hundred Acres of land part of another Tract joining to the said One hundred thirty and four acres of land.

Item I give unto my son Jephtha Dubose his heirs or Assigns Two hundred Seventy and five acres of land being part of a Tract of land containing five hundred and fifty Acres And also one hundred Acres of land on the North side of Santee River And also one hundred fifty and five acres of land more or less on the North side of Santee River.

Item I give unto my Two Daughters Susannah Bersheba Dubose and Bester Dubose their heirs forever a Tract of Land containing Six hundred and forty Acres more or less Equally to be divided by my Executors herein mentioned and the Residue and Remainder of my personal Estate to be Equally divided amongst my Six Children herein mentioned Share and Share alike and I do hereby nominate and appoint Theod. Sailard William Buchanan & Joseph Buggins to be my Executors to this my last Will & Testament and do hereby give my said Executors full power to sell & dispose off three of my Slaves (viz.) Hector Port & Patrick.

I John Thomson being Sick & weak in body but in perfect mind & memory do make my last Will and Testament I commend my Soul to Almighty God that gave it and my body to the hands of my Executors to be decently buried hoping that at the last day of Resurrection we shall cheerfully meet with my Redeemer and ready Employer Jesus Christ.

- Item in the first place my Will is that all my just and lawfull Debts shall be paid.
- Item I give and bequeath to my Eldest Daughter Sarah Thomson wth Plantation Commons called and known by the name of Flower hill joyning upon John Thomson Sen^r.
- Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Thomson wth Plantation joyning the mouth of Jeffries Creek upon Cede River.
- Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Jane Thomson Seven hundred & fifty Acres of Land at the Honours upon Cede River afores^d.
- Item I give & bequeath to my Son John Thomson all my Sands and Tenements and outhouses that to me belongs on the north side of Black River and South side of Black mingo with the manner Plantation where I now live.
- Item I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife and Equal Share with all the Children that is to say all the Negroes and that they shall be Equally divided upon the day of Marriage of my daughter Sarah. I give and bequeath to my loving friend George Senior the best riding horse I have I order that all my out battle shall be sold and all the best of my Estate that is not made mention of I entirely bequeath to my son John Thomson I do constitute and appoint my beloved friends Daniel Serroach & William Fleming & Josiah Garner Dupon and my beloved Wife Ann Thomson to be my Executors to manage my Estate aforesaid in a regular form as they shall think proper.

I Robert Thomson of Craven County in the Province of South Carolina Planter being Sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God therefore do make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following that is to say and principally I recommend my Soul to God Almighty that gave it and my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian & decent manner nothing doubting but I shall receive the same at the general Resurrection thro the merits and mediation of my blessed Saviour and Redeemer Jesus Christ and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I Will and Dispose of the same in manner and form following

Item I Will that all my Lawfull debts be paid.

Item I Will and bequeath all my Personal Estate to my loving Brother John Handlen and my loving Sister Ann Thomson Relict of my Brother William Thomson deceased to be Equally divided betwixt them Share and Share alike.

Item I Will and bequeath my Land being Four hundred Acres to Robert Thomson Son to my Brother William Thomson deceased and his heirs forever.

Item I hereby Revoke & disannul all former and other Wills by me heretofore made and do Appoint my loving Brother John Handlen and my loving Sister Ann Thomson Relict of my Brother William Thomson deceased to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament Ratifying & confirming this none other to be my last Will.
