I Jonathan Wilson in the Parish of St. Bartholomew in Colleton County in the Province of South Carolina Planter being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto Mind the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is Appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the Same again by the Almighty Power of God and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise & dispose of the Same in the following manner and form.

First I Will and ordain that all my Funerall Charges be paid and all my Debtor Debts be discharged by my Executor hereafter mentioned.
Item I give and bequeath all the remaining Part of my Estate to my well beloved friend John Burnham of the Parish and County aforesaid Planter to his heirs and Assigns forever I also constitute and Appoint my trustee and Will beloved friend John Burnham my whole and Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills & legacies & bequests & Executors by me in anywise before named Willed and bequeathed ratifying & confirming this & not other to be my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand & seal the day and year above written.
