And to Ask Collect Every Recover & Receive the s^d goods Rights & Credits & to pay the Debts the s^d Deceased stood Obliged for so far forth as the s^d goods rights & Credits will Extend according to their Rate & C^{on}: in Law being first sworn on the Holy Evangelists well and faithfully to administer the same & for to make a full & perfect Inventory thereof and to Exhibit the same into the Secretary's Office in Charleston at or before the Nineteenth Day of September next Ensuing & to Render a True & Just account Calculation & Reasoning of the said Administration when thereunto requiring And I Do Ordain Depute & Constitute you the said Peter Jeyes Admⁿ of all & singular the goods rights & Credits of the said John Brand Deceased with his s^d Will annexed by Virtue of these presents.
