therefore make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills and Testaments
by me heretofore made and declaring this only to be my last Will and Testament that is to say I Principally
commend my Soul to the Mercies of God in and through the Merits and Mediation of Jesus Christ my dear
Saviour and Redeemer in whom I trust to receive full and free Pardon of all my sins and to inherit Eternal
Life. And my Body at Death I Commit to the Earth to be Buried decently and in a Christian like manner at
the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter named, and as for all my Goods Chattels and such Worlaly Estate as
God hath been pleased to bless me with I will and appoint that the same shall be disposed of in Manner and
form following Vizt:

First. Will and desire that all my just Debts and Funeral Expenses shall be paid and satisfied with all convenient
Speed after my Decease.

Item I do give and Impower my Executors hereinafter named, and the Survivor of them to sell and Dispose of all
and every Part of my Estate whatsoever and wheresoever, absolutely and to the best advantage that can be after my
Decease and after Paying and discharging my Debts and Funeral Charges and other Contingent Expenses
all the surplus and residue of the Money and Effects of my said Estate I bequeath and Give unto my two Children
Namely Anne Tucker my daughter aged Twenty Six years or thereabouts Born in the parish of St Mary Newington
But in the County of Surrey in the Kingdom of Great Britain of my late wife Elizabeth Dec^r and my Son Thomas White
Tucker aged fourteen years or thereabouts Born in the Parish of Kingston at Portsmouth Point in Hampshire in Great
Britain of my late wife Grace which said Anne Tucker and Thomas White Tucker did both lately live at Port-
smouth Point aforesaid to them my said two Children Anne Tucker and Thomas White Tucker equally to be shared and
divided between them living but in case of the Death of either of them and issue of the Body of such deceased Child should be
living then the part or share of such dec^r Child together the respective issue of such Child or children equally to be shared

Item I will and desire that Mr. Benjamin Smith Turner (who goes with me) may be employed to collect my small debts, and that he shall be paid for such his trouble at the rate of two Shillings and six pence for his own use and a shooe for every Twenty Shillings which he shall collect and pay to my said Executors.

Sastly I nominate & constitute and appoint Mess^{rs} James Osmond and Thomas Gambell of Charles Towna foresaid Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

Item I give Devise and bequeath unto my said Dearly beloved Wife Magdalene Elizabeth Izard the one full part after the specific Sigma which is hereinafter mentioned to my Dear Daughter Charlotte and Martha are taken out of all my Personal Estate Goods and Chattels what so ever in the province of South Carolina the whole into four Equal Parts to be divided to have and to hold the same to my said Wife Magdalene Elizabeth Izard
