And I do hereby Authorize and impower my said Exors. and the Survivor & Survivors of them when they shall divide and allot my said Estate in three parts and shall deliver one part thereof to my said Wife as aforesaid to divide the remaining two thirds among my said four daurs and then to allot to each Child her particular Share or part or to keep the said remaining two thirds together and intire untill my said younger daurs shall attain their respective Ages or days of Marriage as aforesaid, and then to allot to my said daurs respectively as they attain their respective ages or day of Marriage as aforesaid Their respective Shares of my said Estate as my said Executor in their discretion shall think fit. And

I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said dear wife Elizabeth Smith Executor and my Brother Peter Taylor and Thomas Dale Esq^r and my loving friends and relatives William Elliott and John Hanyame Exors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making Null and Void all former and other wills by me, heretofore made declaring these Presents to be and contain my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this thirtieth day of December in the year of our Lord, One Thousand seven hundred and fortyone, and in the fifteenth year of his Majesty's reign.

I Paul De St Julien of the Parish of St John County of Berkeley in the province of

South Carolina Gentleman Being this time by the Providence of God afflicted with sickness But of Perfect Mind and memory considering the Mortality of my Body and that it is Ordained that all men should die have thought fit at this time to declare this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following that is to say first and Principally I commend my soul to Almighty God beseeching him to forgive me all my Sins through the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ my Blessed Redeemer and as for my Body I leave it to the Earth to be buried in such manner & place as my Executors hereinafter shall direct And as touching such worldly Estates as it hath pleased God to Bless me with I desire and Dispose of the Same in manner following.

Imprimis I will that all my just Debts and funerall Charges be paid and discharged in convenient time.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary De St Julien my Plantation & now live on Commonly known and Called Hanover consisting of two Tracts of Land making in the whole Seven hundred and Twenty Acres or thereabouts To have and to hold the said Plantation to my said Daughter Mary her heirs and Assigns for Ever. Moreover I give and bequeath unto my said Daughter Mary De St Julien a Plantation or Tract of Land Containing five hundred Acres which I bought of Daniel Couturiers To have and to hold the said Plantation or tract of five hundred acres of Land to my said Daughter Mary her heirs and Assigns for Ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughters Mary De St Julien and Elizabeth De St Julien my Lands on the South side of Santa River Commonly known and Called Emanuel's Bluff Consisting of three Tracts making in the whole One thousand five hundred Acres To be equally divided Between them by a line running from the River my Daughter Mary to have Seven hundred and fifty Acres on the west side of the Dividing line to her her heirs and Assigns for Ever, My Daughter Elizabeth To have Seven hundred and fifty Acres on the East side of the dividing line to her her heirs and Assigns for Ever. Moreover I give and Bequeath unto my Daughters Mary De St Julien and Elizabeth De St Julien my Lands on the North side of Santa River Opposite to the above mentioned Emanuel's Bluff Containing in the whole Six hundred and Fifty six Acres to be Equally divided between them by a line running from the River my Daughter Mary to have three hundred and Twenty Eight Acres on the west side of the dividing line to her her heirs and Assigns for Ever my Daughter Elizabeth to have three hundred and twenty Eight Acres on the East side of the dividing line to her her heirs and Assigns for Ever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary De St Julien one Negro Girl Named Felly.

Item I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Eliz: De St Julien one Negro Girl named Judy.

Item It is my will that if Either of my said Daughters Mary and Elizabeth should happen to Die before they be of Age or without Lawfull Issue of their Bodies that they should Inherit Each others Estate both Real and Personal.

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Mary De St Julien all my household Goods and Furniture my Chaise and one horse Called Bembo. Moreover I give and bequeath unto my said loving wife Mary De St Julien one Negro Woman named Lucy and her youngest Child called Susy.

Item It is my will that my said loving wife Mary De St Julien shall have free liberty to live on my Plantation Called Hanover together with the use of all the Buildings and other conveniences on the said Plantation and to plant and make use of the Lands till my Daughter Mary be of Age or Day of marriage that which shall first happen And whereas I have kept a Store on my plantation Called Hanover for some years past in Copartnership with my Cousin Mr Isaac Mazzyx and that they have been no written articles of Agreement Between us do hereby Declare that the said Isaac Mazzyx is concerned for the half or moiety of all the Goods now in my said

and that he is justly Entitled to the half of all the Bonds notes and Bond Debts due to the said Store And it is my Will that my Executors do Make him full Satisfaction for his said Share in the said Store in convenient Time. It is also my Will that a Tract of Land containing five hundred acres lying on the North side of Santee River which I did purchase from Mr. Abner Crouch Shall be sold by my Exors. Giving them full Power so to do. It is also my Will that the One half of what the said land shall be sold for be paid unto Mr. Isaac Mazzyer he being justly Entitled to the Same the said land being bought for the aforementioned store.

Item It is my Will that the Residue of my Personal Estate after my Debts and just Debts are paid be equally Divided in three parts That is to say One third part to my Loving Wife Mary De St Julien the One third part to my Daughter Mary, and the One third part to my Daughter Elizabeth.

Item It is my will that my Daughter Mary have one Negroe Woman named Sisset after the rate she shall be Appraised at.

Lastly I constitute and Appoint my Loving Wife Mary De St Julien my Loving Brothers James and Joseph De St Julien and my Cousen Mr. Isaac Mazzyer Sole Executors of this my Last Will & Testament Revoking and annulling all other Will or Wills that might heretofore have been made. Sealed with my Seal and Dated the Six day of April in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred & forty One.
