I Thomas Roberts of Johns Island in the parish of St. Johns Colleton County in the Province of South Carolina being Sick and weak but Sound in mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament.

Impr: I give my Soul to Almighty God who gave it me, and body to the Earth from whence it came to be decently Interred at the Discretion of Executors. It is my Will and pleasure that all my lawfull Debts and funeral Charges be paid then I dispose of my Estate which it hath pleased God to Endow me with both

Item real and personal in manner and form following viz:
I give unto my dearly and well beloved Wife Elizabeth Roberts an Equal part of my Estate with my Children during her Natural Life and to give Security that it shall be delivered to my Surviving Children at her decease And one Negroe Girl at her own disposal named Mary.

Item I give unto my Daughters Hannah & Elizabeth Roberts and the Child my beloved Wife is now big with if a daughter then it shall Equally be divided and if a son then he shall have two hundred and Eighty two Acres of Land where he please on the said Tract of Land where I now live and the rest to be divided between my two daughters Hannah & Elizabeth and further it is my Will that my Estate be kept together till my Daughter Hannah arrives to the age of fifteen or marriage and after my lawfull Debts are paid that there be three Negroes bought for the use of the Plantation and no more to be bought unless any one dies and then a good Negro bought in that place and further it is my will no more of my Land be Cleared nor timber cut down excepting that part between the road and my dwelling house where I now live and the fence between John Taylor and me And further it is my Will that after my debts are paid & the negroes bought that what is made off on the Plantation more than the Expences of the Plantation shall be put to Interest till the division be made for the use of my Children And further that if any of my Children die before the age of Fifteen or marriage or dies without lawfull Issue then the Survivors shall Equally divide it among them and in case they all die before the Age of fifteen then it shall come to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Roberts.

Item I also give unto my loving Sister Joanna Roberts four hundred Pounds or four small Negroes of a hundred pound price Each and a Negroe Girl named Jenny with what is specified in some former papers she had of me and to have her living on my Plantation till such time as she is married and if she dies before Marriage then it shall return to my Estate again I now likewise Nominate Constitute and appoint to be my Executors to this my last Will and Testament Mr. James Matthews Esq: Thomas West Mr. James Forquet Mr. Robert Cole Mr. Samuel Shaddock Senior & my beloved Executors and that the Executors meet once

for to consult about the affairs of the Plantation and acknowledging this to be my last Will and Testament and all Other former wills to be void and this only to stand in force As witness my hand and seal this seventh day of february one thousand seven hundred and forty.

This day came before me, Joseph Phipps James Mitter and Jane Campbell three of the Subscribing Witnesses to the within Will who all being truly Sworn Declareth that the Testator Thomas Roberts Signed Sealed & pronounced the within writing to be and contain his last Will & Testament and that he the Testator was then of Sound disposing mind & good understanding & memory at the same time to their belief and also that the other Subscribing Witness Mary Shaddock Signed her mark as witness at the same time in Presence of the said Testator (And also Joseph Phipps & Jane Campbell declareth that the Testator named his Wife to be his Executrix and that it was an Omission in a hurry that the word wife was omitted by the said Joseph Phipps who drew this Will Sworn this 10th April 1742 before me and at the same time Swore Mrs. Roberts Wife to the Testator Executrix

I Claudius Innard of St: Georges Parish in the Province of South Carolina being weak and Sick in body but of Sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in forme following I recomend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God hoping that I shall Enjoy a blessed immortality through the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ: And my body I comitt to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named and as to what Worldly Estate God has bestowed upon me I bequeath and dispose of the same as follows.

Item

I give and bequeath all my real and personal Estate in South Carolina of what nature and kind soever unto Alexander Macklenoy of St: Georges Parish in Berkeley County in the Province aforesaid upon trust and to and for the proper use and behoof of Mary Sangley Hannah Sangley the Child Mrs. Mary Sangley of the Parish and Province aforesaid now goes with, all the above mentioned Children being the proper Issue of the said Mrs. Mary Sangley to be equally divided amongst the said Children Share and Share alike and in case any of the said Children shall decease before they come to age or have lawfull Issue then such their part or Portion to go to the Survivor or Survivors of them And my Will is that the said Alexander Macklenoy do Employ my said Estate after the best manner he may to and for the use and benefit of the said Children and do account to them for the Issues and Profits of my said Estate

Lastly

I do hereby constitute and appoint the said Alexander Macklenoy full and Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal
