In the Name of God Amen.

I give and Bequeath to my Dearl^y Belov'd wife Elizabeth Burnley three Negroes named Jack Maria and Sgrah And two hundred pounds in Money and All my Household Goods (Except one Feather Bed) and one Riding Horse & Eight Cows with their Calves during her Life and after her Death I bequeath the Negro Jack to my son Mathew I Give and Bequeath to my son William Burnley one hundred pound in Money And one Feather Bed.

I Give & Bequeath also to my son Mathew Burnley one hundred pounds in Money And Sixty Acres of Land.

I Give and Bequeath to my son Thomas Burnley one Negro Wench Named Jina and Forty pound in Money & Sixty Acres in Land.

I Give & Bequeath to my son Samuel Burnley Sixty Acres of Land & one hundred pound in money.

I Give & Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Sarah Baker Twenty pounds in Money

I Give unto my Grandson James Burnley Five pound in Money And as for the Remainder of Cattle & Mares kind I Give unto my four Sons to be Equally divided between them.

I Constitute ordain and appoint my dearl^y beloved wife and son Will^m Burnley to be Executors of this my Last Will & Testament and do here utterly Disallow all other Wills Legacies Requests Executors by me before this time named or willd. Confirming and no other to be my Last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixt my Seal this Eighteenth Day of October 1739 years.
