I give devise and bequeath unto Elizabeth Hill of the Parish of St. Andrew in Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina Widow and

my good friend Charles Hill late of the Province aforesaid Esquire. Deceased all my Estate both Real and Personal of what nature kind ~~and~~ Quality so far as the same may be or wheresoever the same may be Situate, Lying or being To have and to hold all my said Estate both real and Personal unto the said Elizabeth Hill her Heirs Executors Admors and Assigns to her and their own proper use and behoof forever and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint the said Elizabeth Hill sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the fourteenth day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty nine, and in the thirteenth year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord King George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith and so forth.
