In the name of God Amen April 15th 1748 I Archibald Hamilton of James Island Planter in the Parish of St Andrews Berkeley County and Province of South Carolina being very sick and weak of Body but of perfect mind and memory thankes be to Almighty God for it therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the hand of God who gave it my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the Discretion of my Exors nothing daulting but at the General resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Almighty Power of God and as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this life I give Devise and Dispose of the same in the following manner and form Itemis I will order and appoint that my funeral charges

with all other debts which I justly owe to any Person or Persons be well and truly paid and Discharged Item I leave orders and appoint that the part of a Tract of Land that I now have a lease of shall be kept till the first day of January next and then to be sold to any Person that will buy the said lease it being part of a Tract of Land belonging to William Lanckster where my Plantation now is Item my Will is that all my Personal Estate Shall be Left together till the first of January next and then to be sold by my Exors Item I Give one half of my Estate to my Brother Pringle Hamilton the other half to be Divided into two parts one Half of which I Give to my Cousin Margaret Hamilton the other to my Cousin Mary Hamilton to them and their Heirs for ever and for the Execution of this my last Will and Testament I constitute and appoint my friend Henry Sheriff & James Hamilton to be Sole Exors Revoking and Disannulling all former Wills Legacies Bequests whatsoever In witness whereof I set my hand & Seal

In the Name of God Amen the Twenty fourth day of March in the Twenty first year of his Majestys Reign anno Domini 1747/8 I Peter Villepontous of Christ Church Parish in the Province of South Carolina Gent^m being of sound and disposing mind and memory blessed be God and considering the uncertainty of this Transitory life and the certainty of death, do therefore make this my last Will and Testament and hereby revoke and Disannull all other Wills and Testaments at any time heretofore made and ordain this only to be and stand as and for my last Will and Testament, and first I commend my soul into the hands and keeping of God my creator trusting only in the merits and mediation of Christ my Saviour & blessed redeemer, for the remission of my sins, and an inheritance in his heavenly Kingdom and my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the expence of my Estate as my Exors hereinafter named shall in their discretion think proper as to my worldly Goods and Chattells, I will and desire that the same be disposed of in the manner following that is to say First I will and Ordain that all my just debts and funeral charges shall be well and truly paid with all convenient speed after
