Lastly I nominate constitute and Ordain my Brother in Law John Scott of Charles Town aforesaid, Shop Keeper, whole and Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament.

I Benjamin Godin of South Carolina Gen: being now in health and of Sound and disposing Mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same yet Calling to mind the Uncertainty of this Trial and Tryal State And that all Flesh must yield unto Death I first and Principally Command my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my greater hoping for Mercy & Salvation in and thro' the Instruments meane of his Son Jesus Christ my Redeemer And my Body I Committe to the Earth to be decently Interred at the Discretion of my Exe<sup>r</sup>c<sup>t</sup> and Exe<sup>r</sup>c<sup>t</sup>s hereinafter named And as for such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to Bestow Upon me I give and Bequeath the same as follows— In primitis I give and Bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Ann Godin the sum of twelve thousand pounds Current money of this Province to be paid her by my Exe<sup>r</sup>c<sup>t</sup> hereinafter named And also her Watch and Rings Together with my Coach and Two Chaises with the Several Horses Commonly Used in and Belonging to them and also all my Riding Horses Item I give and Bequeath unto my said loving wife the Use of the following Slaves Viz: Five men named Little Niga Matt Stafford Abram & Walley Two Boys named Caesar & Billy Nine Women named Phoebe Mally Juba Noll Doll Betty Bella and Sassa and one Negro Girl named Kate or Tub To have and to hold the said severall Slaves unto my said loving wife for and during the Term of her natural Life if she shall so long Continue a widow Item I give and Bequeath unto my said loving wife during the Term of her widowhood Aforesaid the free Use of all my Plantation Household Goods and Implements of Husbandry and Furniture whatsoever in Charles Town and at my Plantation in Goose Creek together Also with the free Use of all my Head Cattle Sheep and Hogs which are upon my said Plantation Item it is my mind

and Will that my said wife shall Reside and Dwell in my House at my Plantation in Socsecuk where I now live And also in my House and Lot in Charles Town No: 40 in such manner & at such times as she my said wife shall be Convenient ffor and During the Term and Continuance of her Widewhood and no Longer Item after the Death or marriage of my said wife it is my Will that my Estates Do Devide or Cause to be Divided my said Lot No: 40 into two Equal parts by Running the line of Division from East to West And the Northernmost Moiety or half part thereof I give and Devise unto my Son David Godin and his heirs And the Southernmost Moiety or half part thereof I give and Devise unto my Son Isaac & his heirs Item after the Death or marriage of my said wife All that my Plantation at Socsecuk aft: when I now live I give Devise and Bequeath unto my said Son Isaac Containing in the whole Two thousand One hundred and Fifty Eight Acres and made up of Six Several Tracts to have and to Hold the same according to the Several Grants and Plotts therof unto my said Son Isaac and his heirs for Ever Item after the Death or marriage of my said wife All and Singular the before Mentioned Slaves Plate Household Goods and Implements of Household Stuff whatsoever I give and Bequeath to and Amongst my Two Sons David & Isaac and my Daughters Elizabeth Woodward Mary Ann Gwendolyn Frances Susannah Judith Charlotte Amelia and Katherine And ~~lives~~ or Survivor of ~~lives~~ in Share and Share alike Item I give and Bequeath unto my ~~lives~~ and Estates herein-

Term of her Natural Life And after her Decease I give and Bequeath the said Sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds unto & amongst Such Child or Children as shall be living at the time of her Death lawfully Begotten of her Body And in Default of such Issue then it is my will that the said Sum of Money become a part of my Personal Estate to be disposed of in such Manner as the Residuary part of such my Estate is herein After directed to be Disposed of Item I give unto my Executors herein after Named or the Survivors or Survivor of them in Trust and for the Use of my Daughter Frances the wife of Frederick Brunswick the Sum of Two thousand Five Hundred Pounds Current money to be placed out at interest on good Security And the Interest money to be paid to her Annually during the Term of her Natural Life And after her Decease I give and Bequeath the said Sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds Unto such Child or Children Lawfully Begotten of her Body as shall be living At the time of her Death and for want of Such Child or Children then the said Sum of Two thousand Five Hundred Pounds I do hereby Give and Dispose of as the Residuary Part of my Personal Estate is hereinafter Given and Disposed of Item I Give Devise and Bequeath unto my Two Sons David and Isaac and unto each of them the Sum of Five thousand pounds Current money And to those my Six Daughters Viz: Mary Susannah Judith Charlotte Amelia & Katherine And each & Every of them such a Sum of Money as together with the Legacies to them Respectively Given by their Grand Father Mr. Dr. Marrych dead will make up in the whole the Sum of Five thousand pounds Current money Provided and upon this condition that none of my said Six Daughters Do Intermarry at any time without the leave and Approbation of my <sup>said</sup> Living
