In the name of God Amen that I Benjamin Postell of the Parish of St. Georges Dorchester in the Province of South Carolina Planter being sick & weak in body but of sound & Perfect mind & memory thank God for the same calling to mind my Mortallity do make and ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following Vizt First & Principally I do Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty god who gave it and my body to the Earth to be Buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named hoping in & Through the merits of our Blessed Lord & Savior Jesus Christ to Receive free Pardon of all my sins and to have a Joyfull resurrection at the last day & as for such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I do give Devise and Bequeath the same as followeth Vizt

In witness I will & desire that all my just debts and Funeral charges
be paid & satisfied by my Executors hereinafter named Mentioned as soon
as they can conveniently do the same Then I give Devise and Bequeath
all my Lands Slaves and the Remainder of all my Estate both real &
Personal to my three Brothers and Sisters John Postell James Postell
Elipah Postell a & Jane Postell to be Equally Divided between Share & Share
alike to be Freely Possessed and enjoyed by my said three brothers & Sister
their heirs and Assigns forever two Negroes Excepted as is hereafter Menta

One Negroe Woman Molley Will & Bqueath is my well Beloved Neice
Sarah Rousham Daughter to James Rousham of the town or Village
of Dorchester Carpenter and one other Negroe Woman named goem to my
Friend Mrs Eliza Moore Daughter to Mr John Moore of Parish aforesaid
Lastly I do hereby nominate affeint Capt Ralph Head Esq^r John
Postell & Elijah Postell of the Parish aforesaid Executors of this my
last Will & Testament Revoking Disannulling and making Void
all Wills by me heretofore made and I do hereby Ratify Confirm
Acknowledege and Declare this to Stand and be for ever as my last

of St: John Colleton County in the Province of South Carolina Planter being
Lick & weak in body but of Perfect mind & memory thanks be Given to Almighty
God therefore Calling to mind the Mortallity of my Body and knowing that it is
Appointed for all men to die I do make and Ordain This my last Will & Testt
that is to say Principally and first of all I give my soul into the hands of God
who gave it and my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a Decent Christian Burial
at the Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting but at the General
Resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the Mighty Power of God who
gave it and as Touching such Worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God
to bless me with in this life I Give and Dispose of the same in the
following manner and form after that my lawfull Debts and Funeral
Charges be Paid Item I Give and Bequeath unto my dear and well Beloved
Wife Vilet Ginks one feather bed with one Saddle & Bridle with her choice of any
horse or mare belonging to my Estate Excepting one mare Called Bonney
Item I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Thos: Ginks my Silver slive
Buckles with one pair of Gold Buttons and my Silver Clasps
I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Daughter Jean Ginks two Gold rings
with half a Doz. of Tea Spoons with one feather bed and one mare Called Bonny
Item it is my will further that all my Estate not yet mentioned both
Real & Personal shall be sold & Equally Divided between my wife Vilet
Ginks and my son Thos: Ginks and my Daughter Jean Ginks and that my
Son and Daughter aforesaid their two Parties shall be put to Interest
Directly after the sale for the use of my said son Thos: Ginks & my 2^d Daug: Jean Ginks
