Admors. and Assigns forever Provided Always that if either of them my said son or Daughter should happen to die before his her or their arrival to the Age of Twenty one year & without Issue of his her or their Respective Bodies Lawfully Begotten then and not otherwise the part or parts share or shares of him her or them so dying shall descend and go to the survivor or survivors of them my said son & Daughters equally to be shared & divided between them to them their heirs & assigns respectively; otherwise shall go and descend unto such deceased son or Daughter's respective Child or Children equally to be shared and divided between them to have and to hold to them their heirs & assigns respectively forever provided also that the several Legacies & Bequests by me herein given bequeathed & devised & to my said wife Sarah are so given devised & bequeathed unto her & an by me meant & intended to be (only) in lieu & full satisfaction & bar of all such dower share, thirds or customary part as she my said wife Sarah hath or may have or shall have or claim of unto or out of all or any part of my Estate Real or Personal whatsoever Wholly I hereby nominate my said wife Sarah Holybush whole & sole Exor. of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I y^e s^t John Holybush have hereunto set my hand and seal y^e s^t Servants Day of November in y^e s^t Twenty third Year of his Majesties reign Anno dⁱ Domini 1749.

In the name of God Amen I Marmaduke Wicks of Charleston Sadler being at present in perfect Health & many thanks be to the Lord but the uncertainty of Life in this World and as I would have my Estate disposed of agreeable to my Desire make this my last will & testament First Committing my Soul to my Creator in full hope from his great mercies to be pardoned from all my sins which I at Signing of this truly repent of. and in full hope of his forgiveness I am in peace.

I Item I desire my Corps may be decently buried according to the form of the Church of England by my Exors hereafter mentioned if they should be dead then by those to whom I leave my worldly Interest

I Item To my request and desire my just & true debts should be first paid

I Item I give & bequeath for many Good reasons also for the affection & Ties I have for George Upman son of William & Mary Upman of Charleston M^{ch} and to him & his heirs forever my negro boy name called Jacob (a s^dller) and also one Snail Trunk in Broad Street joining to the Westward on Land known as Mr. Devenus's

I Item I give & bequeath for the affection & Esteem I have unto Miss Eleanor Upman's Daughter of William & Mary Upman of Charleston the other Trunk under the same roof in Broad Street joining to the Eastward on Cap^t Isaac Holmes & to said Eleanor Upman's her & her heirs forever also a negro called Jethro if living or not sold

I Item I give to George & Eleanor Upman's to them & their heirs forever to be equally divided all my lands and Interest at Wadmalaw as will appear by my Titles unto them

I Item I give & give & bequeath unto my son Jonathan Wicks provided he comes to Carolina to enjoy it the two Trunks in Broad Street before devised to George & Eleanor Upman's conditionally my said son Jon^s will pay to George & Eleanor Upman's four hundred pounds Currency to each or to their heirs or assigns on their paying all their claims to the fore mentioned two Deced^ts to said George & Eleanor Upman's

I Item I give unto my friend Ropton price a suit of mourning also a mourning

I Item I give and bequeath for the affection I have unto George & Eleanor Upman's son of William & Mary Upman after my debts & Legacies be paid all my Real & Personal Estate (excepting what before bequeathed) that may be in the Province of South Carolina.

I Item I appoint my loving friend Ropton price William Upman & William Harvey my Lawfull Exors to see my last Will & Testament
