and of sound disposing mind & memory considering the uncertainty of this transitory life and
the certainty of death do make this my Last Will and Testament and hereby do revoke all
and every other Will and Middle Testament & Testaments whatsoever by me heretofore made or do
make and declare this only to be my last Will and Testament and as such to remain that is
to say Principally I commend my committal soul into the hands of God who gave it
trusting in the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ my blessed Saviour and Redeemer
for the remission of all my sins and through him to obtain eternal life and salvation
and my body I commend to the grave to be decently interred at the discretion of my Executors
hereafter named, And as to the disposition of my worldly estate and estate I will do
give and appoint by these presents that the same shall be as hereinafter is mentioned
I directed first I do hereby nominate constitute and ordain my son in Law William
Kenton Clerk, and Col. Nathaniel Barnwell and Mr. John Barnwell and Hugh
Bryant Esqrs. Executors all of Granville County, in this Province to be Executors of this
my Last Will and Testament and the survivor of them and the Executors & Admors of each, survivor
of them to have and sell my just debts & funeral expenses shall be paid and satisfied with all consent
after my decease. Item, I give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter, Sarah
Chardon my negro boy named Bob and two negro girls slaves named Betty
& Sally together with all their future issue and increase and also one good feather
bed and Bolster and Pillows & Bedding & Linen & Spoons all which shall be delivered
to her when she arrives at the age of Eighteen Years or on the day of her marriage
which shall first happen for the sole use & behoof of my s^d Grand daughter during
the term of her natural life and no longer but in case she shall leave any
issue of her body lawfully begotten then to & for the sole use and benefit of such
issue & every of them equally to be shared and divided between them. Item,
I give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter Mary Kenton my Negro boy slave named Sam
and one negro girl slave named Somar together with all their future issue and increase
and also one Good Feather Bed and Bolster and Pillows & Bedding & Linen & Spoons all
to be delivered to her when she shall arrive at the age of Eighteen years or at the day of
her marriage which shall first happen for the sole use and behoof of my s^d Grand
daughter Mary Kenton during the term of her natural life and no longer but in
case she shall leave any issue of her body lawfully begotten then to & for the sole
use and benefit of such issue & every of them equally to be shared and divided
between them. Item, I give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter Elizabeth Kenton
my Negro girl slave named Wintie a boy and one negro girl slave named Lydia
and one Good Feather Bed and Bolster & Pillows & Bedding & Linen & Spoons all which
to be delivered when she shall arrive at the age of Eighteen years or at
the day of her marriage which shall first happen for the sole use and benefit

of my s^d Grand daughter Elizabeth Kenton during the term of her
natural life and no longer but in case she shall leave any issue
of her body lawfully begotten then to and for the sole use & benefit of
such issue and every of them to be shared & divided equally between them. Item,
I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Richard Kenton my Negro
boy slave named Will and one negro girl slave named Peggy and
one Good Feather Bed and Bolster & Pillows & Bedding & Linen & Spoons all
to be delivered when he shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years or
at the day of his marriage which shall first happen for the sole use and benefit
of my said Grandson Richard Kenton during the term of his natural
life and no longer but in case he shall leave any issue of his body lawfully
begotten then to and for the sole use & benefit of such issue & every of them to be
shared & divided between them. Item, I give and bequeath unto my
Grandson William Kenton of my trustee one Negro boy named
Paul for the sole use & benefit & behoof of him this W^m Kenton his heirs, Executors
& Assigns forever. Item, I give and bequeath unto Mary Powers daughter
of my niece Elizabeth Flowers the sum of One Hundred Pounds Current Money of
the Province aforesaid to be put out to interest in good security within Twelve
months after my decease for the sole use & benefit & behoof of her this Mary
Flowers and to the Principal & Interest thereof to be paid to her when she shall
arrive at the age of Twenty one years or at the day of her marriage
which shall first happen but in case of her death before she shall arrive at the age
aforesaid or is married then to the eldest surviving child that is or shall be born
of my s^d niece Elizabeth Flowers and for want of such child during s^d niece
Elizabeth Flowers. Item, I give and bequeath unto Woodward Flowers son of my
niece Elizabeth Flowers aforesaid the sum of One Hundred Pounds Current Money to be put
out to interest in like manner on good security within Twelve months after
my decease for the sole use and benefit of the said Woodward Flowers and to the
Principal & Interest to be paid him when he shall arrive at the age of Twenty one
years or at the day of his marriage which shall first happen but in case
of his death before he shall arrive at the age aforesaid or is married then to
the eldest surviving child that is or shall be born of my said niece Elizabeth
Flowers I also give and bequeath unto the s^d Woodward Flowers one Lot in Mount
fort containing the Bay known by me to the sole use & benefit of the s^d
Woodward Flowers until he the said Woodward Flowers shall arrive at the
age of Twenty years aforesaid. Item, I give and bequeath unto Thomas Stokes orphan
son of Samuel & Hannah Stokes Dec^d the sum of One Hundred Pounds
Current Money aforesaid to be put out to interest on good security Twelve months
after my decease for the sole use and benefit of the said Thomas Stokes &
both the Principal & Interest thereof to be paid him when he shall arrive at the
age of Twenty one years. Item, I give and bequeath unto my nephew Benjamin
Stanyarne the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money aforesaid of
