in Body but of sound Desposing mind and Memory do make and Declare this  
to be my Last Will and Testament and do dispose of all that Substance which it hath  
Pleased God to bless me withall in manner and form following  
Inprimis I will that all my just Debts & Funeral Charges be fully paid and  
Satisfied and after payment thereof that my English Bible and West-  
minster Confession of Faith and all my gold rings be transmitted to my dear  
Mother Jamett Mitchell widow of Hugh Mitchell of North Britain in the  
Shire of Ayr of the Parish of Dailgairn and that all my Manuscript be  
Transmitted unto my Brother Hugh Mitchell of the City of Edinburgh writer  
and Andrew Mitchell Preacher of the County of Ayr both of North Britain  
Item I hereby Impower and Require my Executors hereafter named to make  
& Proper and Sufficient Title in fee Simple unto Thomas Lacheverell or his  
heirs of that Tract of Land Belonging unto me in St Pauls Parish Joining  
Lands belonging unto Mrs Hiddleston agreeable to an Agreement made with  
him in Writing for the same bearing date the seventeenth day of April last  
hetherwise I Require them to Receive proper Titles in Trust for the use of my  
Estate of Lands Agreed for Verbally by me with the Executors of Colonel John  
Bee Matthew Rocke and Francis Holmes Joining lands belonging Lands  
Belonging to the Estate of John Bee deceased Mr Livingston & Lands  
Belonging unto me and to pay the Purchase money out of the General effects of my Estate  
Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Brother Hugh Mitchell all the Right Title  
Claims or Interest that I am Invested with in Lands houses Tenements heredita-  
ments in the County of Ayr in both Britain unto him and his heirs forever.  
Item my will is and I hereby Impower and Require my Executors to sell and  
Dispose of all the Remainder of my Estate both real and Personal as soon as they  
shall think fit it will be to the Interest of my Legatees  
Item I Give and Bequeath unto Mrs Ann Jackson Four hundred Pounds  
Current money of the Province of South Carolina  
Item I Give unto my deare beloved Mother two hundred Pounds Lawfull  
money of Great Britain Item I Give and unto my two Sisters Jane  
Campbell widow of John Campbell of Archmench in the Parish of Dailgairn  
and Agnes Logan wife of Hugh Logan of Logan in the Parish of Cummoch in the  
Shire of Ayr each of them a Mourning ring and five Pounds Sterling for to  
Purchase Mourning. Item I Give and Bequeath Ezekiel Brandford &  
Samuel Lovale their Successors Executors Administrators and Assigns the sum  
of five hundred pounds Current money of this Province only for and upon the  
Special trust & Confidence and for the only use and Purpose hereafter mentioned  
and Declared of for and concerning the same that is to say that they the said

Ezekiel Brandford & Samuel Lovale and Successors and the Survivors and  
Survivors of them or his Executors or Administrators shall and do well and truly from  
time to time yearly forever place out the said five hundred Pounds at Interest on good  
Security and Recur and pay over such Interest money yearly or as it shall become due  
unto the Presbyterian Ministers for the time being of the Congregation for the time being in  
that town of Ayr (which Interest I give and Bequeath) as often as it becomes due unto  
such Ministers & Ministers for the time being for his & their better Support and Maintenance  
and so all future Interest money to the Respective future ministers aforesaid forever  
and the Principal sum of five hundred Pounds to be kept intire and Remain as a fund  
for the said Purpose forever and my will and meaning is that each and every of the said  
Ministers shall be such as are Qualified and Admited according to the Rules &  
Articles of Presbyterian Church Government and Discipline and in Case of the Death  
of any of the above Trustees the Survivors and Survivor of his Executors or Admirors  
shall and are hereby Impowered and Desired to choose Nominate and Appoint  
such other faithfull Person or Persons either in Connection with or Exclusively of  
themselves or himself to be trustee or trustees for the Purposes aforesaid as he or  
they in his or their Discretion shall think fit who I will shall have the same  
Power trust or authority as if herein particularly named and so tothes Trustees as  
often as any succeeding Trustee or Trustees dye others shall be Appointed by the  
Survivors or Survivor in like manner and with like Powers & Authority to all  
interests and purposed whatsoever forever.  
Item I Give and Bequeath unto Mrs Mary Skiving a Mourning ring  
Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Executors hereafter appointed each a Mourning ring  
& a Suit of Mourning  
Item I Give unto my Sister Margaret Gourner wife of William Gourner minister of  
the Parish of Muirkirk in the County of Ayr North Britain three eights parts  
of the Residue of my Estate ye Residue being in Eight Equal parts Divided to her  
and her heirs forever. Item I Give unto my Brother Hugh Mitchell two eights  
parts of the said Residue of my Estate. Item I Give unto my Brother Andrew  
Mitchell the Remaining three eights of my Estate Lastly I hereby Constitute  
and Appoint my friends James Skiving and John Laird Executors of this my last  
Will and Testament and hereby revoke all former Wills by me made and  
Declare this only to be my Last will & Testament In Witness whereof I have here-  
unto set my hand and seal this third day of December in the year of our Lord  
One thousand Seven Hundred and forty nine <sup>regd</sup> in the twenty third year of his age

In the Name of God Amen the thirteenth day of December Anno Domini one Thousand Seven Hundred forty eight I John Sandiford Son of James Island free maker Berkley County and Province of South Carolina calling to mind the mortallity of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say Principally and first of all I Give and Recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it my Body I Recommended to the earth to be buried in a Christian Decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the Almighty Power of God and as touching such worldly estate were with it hath pleased god to bless me with in this life I Give devise & dispose of the same in the following manner and form

Imprimis I will order and Appoint that my funeral charges with all other debts which I justly owe to any Person or Persons be well and truly paid & dis<sup>d</sup>t Item I Give to my well Beloved Son John Sandiford Ten Pounds Currency to be pay<sup>d</sup> him in four months after my decease to his heirs forever & ye<sup>r</sup>e last of his portion Item I Give to my well beloved Son James Sandiford all that Plantation or tract of land on James Island that I now live on with Turkey Buzzard Island to be delivered to him in four years after my decease by my Executors also one Negroe boy named Roger, my hatters tools, Gun & Cuttermenents and my Wearing Apparel Beddy stuff & Trimming to be used in the four years for the Support of my family but if my son James should dye before he come to the years of twenty one then my Will is that my son Ralph Sandiford shall have the above said lands I now live on, on James Island and the Incalles to be Divided Equally between my three Daughters Ann Schinner Martha and Sarah Sandiford Item I Give to my well beloved son Ralph Sandiford all my tract of Land containing Six hundred Acres on the head of Black River in Wingaw and one Negroe boy named June and my new Gun & Cuttermenents to him & his heirs forever Item I Give to my beloved Daughter Elisabeth Garen my two Negroes Malinda and Hagar also the bed and furniture that she now uses to her & her <sup>heirs forever.</sup> Item I Give to my Beloved Daughter Martha Sandiford Alice & Philip with their Issue and twenty Pounds Currency to be paid her in four months after my decease and is the last of her portion Item I Give to my well beloved Daughter Ann Schinner my two Negroes Malinda and Hagar also the bed and furniture that she now uses to her & her <sup>heirs forever.</sup> Item I Give to my well beloved Daughter Martha Sandiford my two Negroes Silver and Albal also the bed and Furniture she now uses to her & her heirs forever Item I Give to my well Beloved Daughter Sarah Sandiford at the age of Eighteen years my three Negroes Accaba hester & Pitt to her & her heirs forever Item I Give to my well Beloved Grand Daughter Mary Witter my three Negroes Diana Waffen and Malinda who she arrives to the age of Eighteen years but if she dies before she is Eighteen years old my will is that they shall be Equally Divided between my Daughters Ann Schinner Martha & Sarah

Item I will order and appoint that the Remaining part of my Estate Goods Rights & Chattels not Given away shall be kept together four years for the bringing up and Support of my Children unmarried the negroes reserved for them is Lancaster, Ivy, Sampson, Pompey, Cuffee, Luce, Sippow and Effie and after Expiration of the four years my negroes Rights Goods & Chattels Shall be Equally Divided between my five Children or as many of them as shall be then living James, Ralph Ann Schinner, Martha & Sarah Sandiford by my Executors and for the Execution of this my last will and testament I Constitute and appoint my Goods friends Capt Robert Rivers William and James Scivens to be my sole Executors Revoking and Disannulling all former wills Legacies & Bequeathals whatsoever In witness whereof I set my hand & Seal the day and year above written

In the Name of God Amen the twenty seventh day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and forty nine and in the twenty third year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c I William Hendrick of Christ Church Parish in Berkley County in the province of South Carolina Planter being very sick and weak in body but (Blessed be God) of sound and disposing mind and memory and Considering the Certainty of Death and the uncertainty thereof do make and Ordain this my last will & Testament and hereby Revoke and Annul all former and other wills & Testaments by me heretofore at any time or times made or Declared and Declare this and no other to be and remain as and for my only last will and Testament and first and Principally being Truly Present and Sorry for all my sins and humbly Begging Pardon for the same I Command my Immortal Soul to God who gart it trusting wholly in the Merits and mediation of Jesus Christ my Dear Saviour and Redeemer for the Pardon of all my sins
