

In the Name of God Amen, the Eighteenth day of November in the Year of Our Lord God One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Seven I Isaac Symb of Colleton County in South Carolina Minister being infirm in Body & disordered in Constitution But in Perfect Mind & Memory - for which I desire to praise God Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body as it is Appointed unto Man Once to Die do make & Ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is Principally & first of all I give & Recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God that good & for my Body I recommend - ^{my soul into the Hands of Almighty God that good & for my Body I recommend} - ~~merely~~ it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christianlike Manner at the Discretion of my Exors & as touching Such Worldly Estate Wherewith it Hath Pleased God to Bless me in this life I give Bequeath & dispose of the Same again in the Manner & form following Inprimis it is my Will that all my Estate Should be sold at Public Vendue after the Auction be set out Excepting that Part I Received with my Wife - Agnes Symb by Virtue of Marriage Item I Will & bequeath to my - Beloved Wife Agnes Symb all that Real & Personal Estate Which is Bequeathed to her by virtue of her fathers Richard Purcells Will I Will and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Hugh Symb all the Moneys that is Made After the Sale of my Estate & all my Lawfull Debts is paid - Item it is my Will that my after named Exors give in trust to my beloved Friends Mr. Henry Shierreff on James Island & Mr. William Chambers on Wadmalaw Island all that money that Remains in his Hands after my debts is Paid as is Above mentioned to be Put to Trust by these my trustees for the Use & Benefit of my Beloved Son Hugh Symb Item it is my Will that When Any of these my trustees dyes then the Surviving Trustee Shall Immediately Choose & Appoint Another Proper Person to Act & dew in the Name & Place of the deceased Item it is my Will that in Case my beloved Son Hugh Symb dyes before he Comes to Age or his Lawfull Heirs of his Own Body that then my Above named Trustees Shall take that money I have Bequeathed to him & divided into three Parts One part to be given to my beloved Brother William Symb & the Heirs of his Body One Other Part to be given to my Beloved Half Brother David Symb When he Comes to Age & the Other third Part to be Given to my Beloved Nephew William Adrain & in Case my Beloved Brother William Symb or Half Brother David Symb or Nephew William Adrain then or Either of them dyes Without Lawfull Issue that then the Part to be given to them Shall Return to my Beloved Wife Agnes Symb & the Lawfull Heirs of her Body Lastly I do Nominate Constitute & Appoint my Well Beloved friend Mr. Hugh Wilson of Wadmalaw Island to be & Act as Exor of this my Last Will & Testament & I do hereby make Void & Null & of now force in Law all Others Wills & Testaments by me heretofore maid

I Thomas Cook of Charles Town in the Province of South Carolina Ship Carpenter being Weak in Body but of Sound & disposing Mind Memory & Understanding do make - Publish & declare this to be & contain my Last Will & Testament in Manner & form following Viz: Inprimis I Commit my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God who save it Hoping for Salvation thro the Merits of my Blessed Saviour Jesus Christ & my Body I give to the Earth to be Buried at the discretion of my Exors hereinafter named & Appointed - Item my Will is that all my just debts & funeral Expenses be paid by my Exors After mentioned Item I give Devise & Bequeath all my Estate Either real or personal of whatsoever Kind or Nature the Same may be or Which I am or shall be possessed of or intituled into at the time of my Decease - Within the Province of South Carolina Whether Bonds Notes Book debts Goods Chattell & other Effects to my Loving friend John Scott of Charles Town & to his Heirs & Assigns for ever In trust Nevertheless to ly him to & for the Use benefit & behoof of the South Carolina Mechanick Society of which I am a member all which Goods & Chattells Book debts Bonds Notes & Effects I desire the said John Scott may convey & Give to the Use of the said Society as soon as the Same can conveniently be Got in & gathered together to have & to hold the said Effects to & for the Use of the said South Carolina Mechanick Society & to & for no Other Use whatsoever & I hereby Nominate - constitute & Appoint the said John Scott Exor of this my Last will & Testament Revoking all Other Wills by me heretofore made & declaring this to be my Last Will & Testament In Witness Whereof I have to this my Last Will & Testament Set my hand & Seal the Seventeenth day of February Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred & forty Six
