 Discretion of my Execr & as Touching Such Worldly Estate Wherewith
 it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give bequeath & dispose
 of the same again in the manner & form following Inprimis it is
 my Will that all my Estate Should be sold at Public Vendue after
 the debts are paid out Excepting that Part I Received with my wife -
 Agnes Sym by Virtue of marriage Item I will & bequeath to my
 Beloved wife Agnes Sym all that Rail & Personal Estate Which is
 Bequeathed to her by virtue of her fathers Richard Purcells Will
 I will and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Hugh Sym all the money that
 is made after the sale of my Estate & all my Lawfull Debts is paid -
 Item it is my Will that my after named Execr give in trust to my beloved
 Friends Mr. Henry Sheriff on James Island & Mrs. William Chambers
 on Wadmalaw Island all that money that remains in his Hands after
 my debts are paid as is above mentioned to be put to Intrest by these my
 trustees for the Use & Benefit of my Beloved Son Hugh Sym Item it is
 my Will that when any of these my trustees dies then the surviving
 trustee shall immediately close & Appoint another Proper Person to
 act & sue in the name & place of the deceas'd Item it is my Will that in
 case my beloved Son Hugh Sym dies before he comes to Age or his Lawfull
 Heirs of his own Body that then my above named Trustees shall take
 that money I have bequeathed to him & divided into three parts one part
 to be given to my beloved Brother William Sym & the Heirs of his Body
 one other part to be given to my beloved Half Brother David Sym
 when he comes to Age & the other third part to be given to my beloved
 Nephew William Adrain & in case my beloved Brother William
 Sym or Half Brother David Sym or Nephew William Adrain them
 or either of them dies without Lawfull Issue that then the part to be
 given to them shall return to my beloved wife Agnes Sym & the lawfull
 heirs of her Body lastly I do nominate constitute & Appoint my well
 beloved friend Mr. Hugh Wilson of Wadmalaw Island to be & act as
 Execr of this my Last Will & Testament & I do hereby make Void & Null &
 of no force in Law all Others Wills & Testaments by me heretofore maid

 I am or shall be possessed of or intituled unto at the time of my Decease -
 Within the Province of South Carolina Whether Bonds Notes Books
 debts Goods Chattel

their Effects to my Living friend John Scott of
 Charles Town & to his Heirs & Assigns for ever in trust
 Nevertheless to by him to & for the Use Benefit & behoof of
 the South Carolina Mechanick Society of which I am a member all
 which Goods & Chattells Books debts Bonds Notes & Effects I desire
 the said John Scott may receive & Give to the Use of the said Society as
 soon as the same can conveniently be got in & gathered together to
 have & to hold the said Effects to & for the Use of the said South Carolina
 Mechanick Society & to & for no other Use whatsoever & I hereby renin
 ate Constitute & Appoint the said John Scott Execr of this my Last Will
 & Testament Revoking all Other Wills by me heretofore made & declaring
 this to be my Last Will & Testament In Witness Whereof I have to
 this my Last Will & Testament set my hand & Seal the Seventeenth day
 of February anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred & forty Seven
