 the uncertainty of this mortal life do make and declare these presents to stand
 contain my last will and testament, first & principally Recommending my
 mortal soul unto the hands of almighty God my Great Creator trusting
 in the merit and Intercession of my blessed Savior for pardon & Remission
 of all my sins and a happy admittance into the regions of bliss &
 Immortality my body I commit to the Earth from whence it was taken
 to be decently buried at the discretion of my Ex^{ts}: Henr. after named and
 touching the disposition of such worldly Estate which it hath pleased Almighty
 God to bless me I give devise and bequeath the same in manner and form
 following that is to say First I will and order that all my just debts and
 funeral Charges be paid & satisfied with all convenient speed after my
 decease by my Ex^{ts}: Henr. after named and appointed and that no
 Division or Separation of my Estate be made till after my debts & Expenses
 aforesaid are paid & discharged Item I give and Bequeath to my dear
 beloved Sister Martha Eaton one hundred Pounds Currency by my Ex^{ts}: Henr. after
 named to be paid in twelve months after my decease

Item I give and devise to my wellbeloved Brothers in Law William Jenkins & William
 Lawton or to their heirs or assigns forever in trust for and for the use and
 support of the Gospel in the Presbyterian Congregation on Edisto Island and
 for no other use whatever to be paid in twelve Months after my decease
 by my Ex^{ts}: Henr. after named one hundred pounds Currency

Item I give & Bequeath unto my beloved son James Black all that part of a
 tract of Land left by my father to be divided between my brother Jeremiah
 Black and myself which said Land after my fathers death divided
 between my brother and I by Henry Yonge to have and to hold the same

to my said son James Black his heirs & assigns forever Item I give and
 Bequeath unto my beloved son James Black all that tract of Land which I
 bought of Wth Daniel Whitwell to have and to hold the same to my said son
 James Black his heirs or assigns forever further more I will and order that all
 or any part of my aforesaid Lands which are already leased or rented out by
 my Ex^{ts}: Henr. after named allowing only pine timber for fencing and
 firewood to be cut down that is to say no oak or other profitable timber
 beside pine as aforesaid and in case it should so happen that my said James
 Black should depart this life without any lawful Issue or attain the
 age of eighteen years then I give devise & bequeath all that part of my
 Lands lying and being on the Southwest Side of the high road as it is now
 laid out to my beloved nephew James Landon Black to him his heirs & assigns
 forever

Item I give devise & bequeath (in case of my sons James Black death as above
 mentioned before he attain the age of Eighteen years or without lawful
 Issue) all the rest & Remain of my Lands unto my nephew Jeremiah
 Black his heirs & assigns forever but if it should so happen that
 either of my said Nephews should die without lawful Issue
 then I give and Bequeath the said Lands to the survivor of them their
 heirs & assigns forever Item I give and Bequeath to my son James
 Black a negro boy called A the said James Black during his minority
 and to his heirs and assigns forever Item I will and Order that
 the residue of my personal Estate be sold within twelve months after
 my decease by my Ex^{ts}: Henr. after named and the money arising
 from the sale to be put out to Interest and the Interest arising from
 the monies so put out to be for a Christian Education and Support of
 my son James Black

Item I will and order that the Surplus Interest monies after his
 Education & Support till he attain to the age of Eighteen years (if any) with
 all my Estate both real & personal be bequeathed to my son James
 Black at the aforesaid age of eighteen years & I Henr. declare him
 to have been born on the sixteenth day of October in the year of
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred & forty four but if it
 should so happen that my son James Black should die before
 he attain the age of Eighteen years or without lawful Issue
 then I give and Bequeath unto my Brothers in Law William
 Jenkins & William Lawton two hundred pounds Currency more
 in trust for and for the use & support of the Gospel in
 the Presbyterian Congregation on Edisto Island and of the
 of the one hundred aforesaid given in this my will and all the
 rest and residue of my personal Estate I will and order to be
 Equally Divided between and among my nephews and

In the name of God Amen The Twenty fifth day of October one thousand seven hundred & forty six I Martha McGregor of St Thomas & James Parish in the Province of South Carolina Widow being in perfect health mind & memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament as follows. I'mprimis my Will and desire is that; that all my debts be paid by my Executors hereafter named out of my Estate. I'm I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth McGregor to her and her heirs my Negro Wench called Stator & all her Children that she now has or may have And I also give and bequeath to my said Daughter Elizabeth to her and her heirs One thousand Pounds she takes her choice of all my Bonds to that amount. I'm I leave my old Negro Wench called Lucy to her own choice to live with which of my Relations she chooses without any controul or wages to be paid for her and I do also direct and order my Daughter Elizabeth to pay tax and board the said Wench Lucy yearly at her own Expence. I'm I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth McGregor to her and her heirs the half of the remaining part of my Interest both Real & Personal. I'm I leave in trust with my Brother Thomas Abin & Mr John Hargeton the Residue of my Interest both Real & Personal for the use of my Daughter Mary Collins & the heirs of her Body & I do also order my Trustees to keep the Money at Interest & to hire out the Slaves they paying the yearly Income of the money and Slaves to my Daughter Mary Collins & upon her decease to the heirs of her Body in case they arriv to the age of Twenty one Year or day of Marriage & in case my Daughter Mary Collins should die without heirs of her Body I then give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth McGregor to her and her heirs all that part of my Interest that I left in trust for my Daughter Mary Collins & in case both of my Daughters Elizabeth McGregor & Mary Collins should die without Issue heirs of their Body arriving to the age of Twenty one Year or day of Marriage excepting my Daughter Elizabeth McGregor makes a Will & disposes of it I then give and bequeath my whole Interest both real & Personal to be equally divided between my Brothers & Sisters & their heirs for ever I'm my Will is that if either of my trustees should refuse to act or die that then my acting & surviving Trustee shall appoint another Trustee to Act in the Room of ^{or} one so refusing or dying & the surviving Trustee shall always have Power to choose another Trustee till my will be fulfilled I'm I do hereby appoint my Daughter Elizabeth McGregor my sole Executrix and I do also appoint my Brother Thomas Abin & Mr John Hargeton Trustees to my Daughter Mary Collins and the heirs of her Body to the my last Will and Testament revoking and making void all
