Testament in form following, I recommend my Soul into the hands
of Almighty God hoping that I shall enjoy a Blessed Immortality -
through the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ and my body I commit
to the Earth to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors -
hereafter named and as to what worldly Estate God has bestowed upon
me I Bequeath and Dispose of the Same as follows. I Give and
Bequeath unto Robert Miller Junr. Twenty four Pounds to be Put to
Interest untill he Comes to age I Give and bequeath unto Susannah
Miller Daughter of Robert Miller Fifty Pounds and to be Given into the
hands of Elizabeth Postell and her to Dispose of it for her as she Sees Proper
I Give & Bequeath unto my Brother John Shute my Negro Girl named
Woll and the Increase of her Body and all the Rest of my Personal & Real Estate
Whatsoever I Possess During his Life, and after his Death to go to the heirs
of his Body and if he Should die Without Issue to go to his next heirs
And I do make and Assign my Execs Robert Miller my Brother John
Shute and Samuel Postell to be Executors of this my Last Will & Testament
And I do hereby Utterly Disallow Revoke and Dissavall all and Every former
Testaments Wills Legacies and Bequests & Executors by me in any Wise before
named Willed and Bequeathed, ratifying and Confirming this and no other to
be my Last Will and Testament In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto
Set my hand and Seal the Twenty Sixth Day of February Anno Domini
1748/9

Memory (Blessed be God therefore) do this Twentieth day of December in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred forty eight ^{make bond} publish this
my Last Will & Testament in manner & form following (that is to say) Unimpaired
I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it me, & my Body
to the Earth whence it came in hopes of a joyful Resurrection through the
merits of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ And as for that worldly Estate
where with it has pleased God to Bless me I dispose thereof as follows: First I
Direct & appoint that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid & satisfied
I Give devise & bequeath to my Daughter Jane Dutty Wife of William
Dutty of Charles Town in the Province aforesd her Execs Admors or Assigns two
Negro Men named Jan & Fortune I Give & bequeath to my Grand
Daughter Margaret Dutty her Execs Admors or Assigns one Negro Woman
named Betty together with her son named Joe to be delivered her by my
Execs hereafter mentioned as soon as she shall arrive at the age of sixteen years
or the day of her marriage which shall first happen I Give to my said
Grand Daughter Margaret Dutty her Execs Admors or Assigns the Sum of
Forty Pounds current money of the Island of Antigua to be paid by my
Execs hereafter mentioned when she shall arrive at the Age of sixteen or
at her day of marriage which shall first happen I Give to my
Daughter Jane Dutty Wife of William Dutty the Sum of Forty Pounds
current money of the Island of Antigua I Give to my Grandson
James Boone Dutty his Execs Admors or Assigns one Wench named Mary come
& one Boy named Anthony I Give devise & bequeath to my Loving Wife
Margaret Boone All my Lands & Tenements in the Island of Antigua to hold

To her during her Natural Life, she making no Waste or Destruction there upon; And from & after her Decease I give Devise & Bequeath the same to my said Grandson James Boone Dutton his Heirs & Assigns for ever. Item I give to my said Loving Wife Margaret Boone All the rest & residue of my Estate both Real and Personal And I make constitute & ordain my said Loving Wife my Executrix & my Son William Dutton and my friend Samuel Peronneau my Exors of this my last Will & Testament

manner & form following that is to say, I recommend my Soul to Almighty
God hoping for Eternal Life through the merits of my Lord & Saviour Jesus
Christ my Body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried at the
Discretion of my Exors hereafter named & as to such Worldly Estate as God
has bestowed upon me I Dispose of the same as followeth (to wit)
I Will that all my Just Debts be paid I give & Bequeath unto my Wife
Sarah Diston all those Ten Slaves which belonged to her before our
intermarriage & I Give her full Licence & Liberty during the time she
shall continue my Widow & no longer to Dwell & Inhabit in the House
which was formerly inhabited by Mrs. Paul Jennis on Ashley River

about two Miles from Dorchester & I do hereby Declare that my Will &
meaning is that what I have herein above given & Bequeathed to my said
Wife is in full of her Dower & thirds & all & every other Claim & Demand
whatsoever which she now hath or hereafter may have Claim Challenge
or Demand of in to or out of my Estate Real or Personal & upon express
Condition that if my said Wife shall make sue or Prosecute any Claim or
Demand or Challenge of in to or out of my Estate Real or Personal or any
part thereof whatsoever that then this Request shall be absolutely void
I Give Devise & Bequeath to the Commissioners for founding Erecting
Governing Ordering & Visiting a Free School at the Town of Dorchester
in the Parish of St. George in Berkley County for the use of the Inhabitants
of South Carolina the Sum of Five hundred Pounds Current money of this
Province for the use of the said School to be raised by my Executrix out of my
Estate & to be paid as soon as Conveniently may be after my Decease
I Give and Devise unto my Cousin Walter Izard the Younger All
that my Tract of Land containing Eighty nine Acres with the Appurtenances
Situate in Berkley County Bounding North Eastward on Land laid out
to Mrs. Thomas Baker & all other Sides on Land heretofore laid out to
Lady Blake to hold the said Eighty nine Acres with the Appurtenances
to him the said Walter Izard the Younger & his heirs & Assigns for ever
Item I Give & Devise All that my Tract of Land containing five hundred
Acres with the Appurtenances Situate on Combahee River in Granville
County Bounding to the Northwest on Combahee Island & on all other
Sides on Marsh & Creeks leading out of Potoyall River unto Joseph Izard
Son of Walter Izard Esq the elder & to his heirs forever but in Case the said
Joseph Izard should happen to Die without Issue I Devise the said five
hundred Acres to Ralph Izard & his heirs forever. I also Give & Devise
unto Francis Izard all that my Tract of Five Hundred Acres of Land on
Combahee Island in Granville County Bounding to the Northward on
