I command my Soul into the hands of Almighty God hoping That I shall enjoy a Blessed Immortality - through the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ and my body I commit To the Earth to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors - hereafter named and as to what Worldly Estate God has Beloved upon me I Bequeath and Dispose of the same as follows. Item I give and Bequeath unto Robert Miller Junr Ninety four Pounds to be Put to Interest until he Comes to age Item I give and bequeath unto Susannah Miller Daughter of Robert Miller Fifty Pounds and to be given into the hands of Elizabeth Postell and her to Dispose of it further as she sees Proper Item I give & Bequeath unto my Brother John Shute my negro Girl named Trull and the Increases of her Body and all the Rest of my Personal & Real Estate whatsoever Possess during his Life, and after his Death to go to the heirs of his Body and if he Should die Without Issue to go to his next heirs And I do make and ordain my Uncle Robert Miller my Brother John Shute and Samuel Postell to be Executors of this my Last Will & Testament And I do hereby Utterly Disallow Revoke and Disannul all and Every former Testaments Wills Legacys and Bequests & Executors by me in any wise before named made and bequeathed, ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament In witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty Sixth Day of February Anno Domini 1748/9

In the name of God Amen I James Boone of Charles Town in the Province of South Carolina being in good health & perfect memory (Blessed be God therefore) do this twentieth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred forty eight <sup>more or less</sup> publish this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form following (that is to say) I command my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it me, & my Body to the Earth whence it came in hopes of a joyful Resurrection through the merits of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ And as for that Worldly Estate where with it has pleased God to Bless me I dispose thereof as follows First I Direct & appoint that all my just Debts & Funeral expences be paid & satisfied Item I give devise & bequeath to my Daughter Jane Dutty Wife of William Dutty of Charles Town in the Province aforesaid her Estates Admons or Apeigns two negro men named Tom & Fortune Item I give & bequeath to my Grand Daughter Margaret Dutty her Estates Admons or Apeigns one negro Woman named Betty together with her Son named Joe to be delivered her by my Executors hereafter mentioned as soon as she shall arrive at the age of Sixteen years or the Day of her Marriage which shall first happen Item I give to my said Grand Daughter Margaret Dutty the sum of Forty Pounds current money of the Island of Antigua to be paid by my Executors hereafter mentioned when she shall arrive at the Age of Sixteen or at her day of Marriage which shall first happen Item I give to my Daughter Jane Dutty Wife of William Dutty the sum of Forty Pounds current money of the Island of Antigua Item I give to my Grandson James Boone Dutty his Estates Admons or Apeigns one Woman named Mary come & one Boy named Anthony Item I give devise & bequeath to my Loving wife Margaret Boone All my Lands & Tenements in the Island of Antigua to hold

to her during her natural life, she making no Waste or Destruction there  
upon; And from & after her Decease I give devise & Bequeath the same  
to my said Grandson James Boone Duthy his Heirs & Assigns for ever.  
Item I give to my said Loving wife Margaret Boone All the rest & residue  
of my Estate both Real and Personal And I make constitute & ordain my  
said Loving wife my Executor & my Son William Duthy and my Friend  
Samuel Penman my Executrix of this my Last Will & Testament

Christ my Body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried at the  
Burial of my dear mother named & a. & such worldly Estate as God  
has bestowed upon me I Dispose of the same as followeth (to wit)  
I will that all my just debts be paid I give & Bequeath unto my wife  
Sarah Dixon all those ten slaves which belonged to her before our  
intermarriage & I give her full licence & liberty during the time she  
shall continue my widow & no longer to dwell & Inhabit in the house  
which was formerly inhabited by Mrs. Paul Jennis on Ashley River

bout two Miles from Dorchester & I do hereby declare that my Will &  
meaning is that what I have herein above given & bequeathed to my said  
wife is in full of her Dower & Thirds & all & every other claim & Demand  
whatsoever which she now hath or hereafter may have claim challenge  
or Demand of in to or out of my Estate Real or Personal & upon express  
Condition that if my said wife shall make sue or Prosecute any claim or  
Demand or Challenge of in to or out of my Estate Real or Personal or any  
part thereof whatsoever that then this Bequest shall be absolutely void  
I Give Devise & Bequeath to the Commissioners for founding Erecting  
Governing Ordering & Visiting a Free School at the Town of Dorchester  
in the Parish of St George in Berkley County for the use of the Inhabitants  
of South Carolina the Sum of Five hundred Pounds Current money of this  
Province for the use of the School to be raised by my Executor out of my  
Estate & to be paid as soon as conveniently may be after my Decease  
I Give and Devise unto my Cousin Walter Izard the Younger all  
that my Tract of Land containing Eighty nine Acres with the Appurtenances  
Situate in Berkley County Bounding North Eastward on Land laid out  
to Mrs. Thomas Carter & all other sides on Land heretofore laid out to  
Lady Blake to hold the said Eighty nine Acres with the Appurtenances  
to him the said Walter Izard the Younger & his heirs & Assigns for ever  
Item I Give & Devise all that my Tract of Land containing five hundred  
Acres with the Appurtenances Situate on Cambahue River in Granville  
County Bounding to the Northwest on Cambahue Island & on all other  
sides on Marsh & Creeks leading out of Portroyall River unto Joseph Izard  
Son of Walter Izard Esq the elder & to his heirs forever but in Case the said  
Joseph Izard should happen to die without issue I Devise the said five  
hundred Acres to Ralph Izard & his heirs forever. I also Give & Devise  
unto Francis Izard all that my Tract of Five Hundred Acres of land on  
Cambahue Island in Granville County bounding to the Northward on
