I Recommend to the Earth to be decently Buried by my Executors hereafter named
According to their Discretion

And as to my worldly Estate both real and Personal
wherewith it hath pleased god to bless me my will + desire is that my Exec^t
hereafter named Should Immediately after my Decease take the same into their
Possession and to sell and dispose thereof as they should think most Proper +
Convenient for the Payment of my just debts and my further will is that after
the Payment of my debts as aforesaid the residue and Remainder thereof shall
be and it is my Express Desire that the same shall be Remain in the hands of
my Executors In trust to and for the Education Maintenance and Support
of my Beloved Daughter Sarah Hilliard During her Minority

And Lastly I do hereby Nominate Ordain Constitute and Appoint my well
beloved Friends Mr. Thomas Bolton and Mr. Hall Richardson of Charlestowm
aforesaid to be Executors of this my Last Will + Testament Willing and
Requiring them in full Confidence of their Integrity to see this my last
Will and Testament duly Executed and that they will give to my
Beloved Cousin Mrs. Mary Richardson one full suit of Mourning cloths to be

Paid for out of my Estate And I do hereby revoke and Disannul all former Wills
by me heretofore made and Acknowledge this only to be my Last Will + Testament
In witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal This Thirtieth day
of October in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty nine
and in the twenty third year of his Majesties Reign
