

In the Name of God Amen the 15th day of August 1744 I Patrick Lindsey of Williams Burg being Sick in Body but of good & Perfect Memory thanks be to ~~god~~ Almighty God & Calling to Remembrance the Uncertain Estate of this transitory life & that all flesh must yield unto death When it shall Please God to Call do make legitimate ordain & declare this my Last Will & Testament In manner & form following Revoking & Annulling by these presents all & Every former Will & Wills heretofore by me made & declared Either by Word or Writing & this is to be taken only for my Last Will & Testament & none other & first being Penitent & Sorry from the Heart for my sins Past most Humbly desiring forgiveness for the same I Give & Commit my Soul unto Allmighty God my Saviour & Redemer in Whom & by the merits of Jesus Christ I Trust & believe Assuredly to be Saved & to have Remission & forgiveness of all my sins & that my soul With my Body at the General day of Resurrection shall Rise Again With joy & through the merits of Christ death & Pation Possess & Inherite the Kingdom of Heaven Preserved for his Elect & Chosen & my Body to be Buried Decently by my Exors hereafter named to Appoint & now for the Settling of my Temporal Estate & such Goods Chattels & debts as it hath Pleased God for Above my Deserts to bestow upon me I do Order give & dispose the Same in manner & form following (that is to say) first I Will that all those debts & dues that I ow in the Right to Any manner of Person or Persons whatsoever shall be Well & truly Contented & Paid or Ordered to be Paid Within convenient time After my Decease By my Exors hereafter named Item I Give & Bequeath to Mary my beloved Wife the Sixth Part of all my Temporal Estate & A third Part of my Reale Estate Includin the time she Continues my Widow but if she marry to have no share or title to Any thing more then A childs Part of the moveables ^{in my Will} that all my Children have An equall Part of all Goods Chattels money moveables What Ever & I will & Bequeath my Land to James & William my Sons to be Equally divided Betwixt them When Come to Maturity & if any of my Children should Prove disobediant to their Mother & my Exors In that Case It shall be in their Power to take their Part & divide Equally - Amongst the Rest & have no Power to Dispose of any thing Without the Consent of their Mother & my Exors hereafter named & Appointed Witnefs Published & declared the day & Year of God above mentioned

In the Name of God Amen, I James Martin of Bartholomew Parish in Colleton County in the Province of S^c Carolina Planter, being Weak in Body but of Perfect mind & Memory Thanks be given unto God - Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body & knowing that it is Appointed for All men Once to die do make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament that is to say first of all I Recommend my Soul unto God Who Gave it & my Body to the Earth to be Decently Interred at the discretion of my Exors herein after mentioned & As touching such Worldly Wealth Wherewith it hath Pleased God to bless me With in this life I Give Demise & Dispose of the Same in the following manner & form Inprimis I Give & Bequeath = th unto my Well Beloved Son Barack Martin to him his Heirs & Assigns for Ever the Tract of Land I now Live on With the Small Tract of Kings Land Bounding to the Westward on One Branch of Afrepas River - Commonly called the Horseshoe Creek & To the Eastward on the Above men- = tioned Tract of Land by him the Said Barack Martin Peaceably to be Possess after the Dividing of the Estate & I also Give unto my son the said Barack Martin the One Third Part of a Tract of Land at Saltcatchers Purchased of Moses Norman of Beach Hill late Deceased Item I Give & bequeath unto my two Youngest Sons John & Ezra Martin all that Plantation (being three Tracts of Land) Which I lately Purchased of = Meffrs^r John & William Mathews to be Equally Divided at the = Discretion of my Exors Between the two Brothers the said John & Ezra Martin Whenever they Arrive to the Age of Twenty One Years & also the Remaining two third Parts of the Above mentioned Tract of Land at Saltcatchers which (as my Exors shall think most Proper & for the = Advantage of my Sons) may either be sold or Equally Divided when my Sons Come of Age Provided Nevertheless that if any or Either of these my Younger Sons John or Ezra Martin Should Die before they Arrive to the Age of Twenty One Years then the Surviving Brother of these two Above mentioned shall Inherit the Portion of the Deceased Brother - Item my Will and Desire is that all my Estate should be kept together till all my Debts be Discharged & paid & then all my moveable Estate to be Equally Divided (at the Discretion of my Exors) among all my Children Vizt Barack Martin Hannah Gibbons (now Wife to Joseph Gibbons Jun^r) Sarah Martin John Martin & Ezra Martin to be for them

their Heirs & assigns for ever. Lastly I do hereby nominate Ordain
Constitute & Appoint my Well beloved Son Barak Martin & my friends
George Hayne & John Mitchell Executors to this my Last Will & Testament
Hereby Revoking Disallowing & Disannulling all & Every other former
Will Legacy & Bequeath by me in Any Wise heretofore Willed named or
Bequeathed or Any thing Contrary to the Purport of these Presents by
me in Any Wise heretofore mentioned Ratifying & Confirming this &
No other to be my Last Will & Testament In Witness Whereof I have

dower & Portion one third Part of All my Personal Estate after my Debts
and Legacies hereafter mentioned are Paid & Discharged to her & her
Heirs for ever & her maintenance of the Plantation such as the Plantation
off^d during the time She Continues my widow & no longer Provided -
thence the less that she my said wife Mary shall & do Within Six Months
after my Decease make Sign seal & deliver unto my Executors hereafter named
a good Effectual & Absolute Release in the Law of form & Against all & all
manner of Other right share Interests Dower & Customary Part whatsoever
Which She hath or may or Ought to have require claim or demand by any
way or means whatsoever.

Then I Give & Bequeath unto my Cousen Mary Macnease one Hundred Pounds
Currency to be Paid her Six Months After my Decease With one Horse & Saddle
such as my Executors & Executors hereafter named shall think Proper & her main-
tainence of the Plantation during her Continuing a single life such as the
Plantation shall afford Then I Give unto my niece Martha Perry her
maintenance of my Plantation such as the Plantation offords till the day
of her marriage & no longer Then I Give & Bequeath unto my Aunt
Mary Carmichael during her Natural life one Negro Girl called Rofey
& her maintenance of my Plantation such as my Plantation offords
Then I Give & Bequeath unto my Beloved Mother Martha Reiley during
her Natural life one Hundred Pounds Currency to be Paid her Yearly as
She shall think Proper out of my Estate also one Horse named Jockey -
Then I Give & Bequeath unto my Well Beloved Daughter Martha
all the Remaining Part of my Estate Both Real & Personal to her & her
Heirs for ever But She dying without Lawfull Issue of her Own Body to
be Equally divided Between my Two Brothers or their Lawfull Heirs to
wit Charles Reiley & John Reiley their Heirs Executors or assigns for
ever Lastly I constitute and Appoint my Well Beloved Brothers Charles -
Reiley & John Reiley Executors & my Well Beloved Wife Mary Reiley & my
Aunt Mary Carmichael Executors of this my Last Will & Testament.

Testaments Legacies & Bequeaths by me made or Bequeathed Ratifying
& Confirming this & no other to be my Last Will & Testament In -
