 term of four years. I give and Bequeath my well beloved Son

 part of the ^{two} tracks Containing five Hundred and fifty acres one negro boy
 named July five Cows and Calves two Mares known by the names
 of Briches and Pacing Dun whom I will that he live with his mother
 During his minority. Item I give and Bequeath to my well beloved Daughter
 Ann Raisford five Cows and Calves to be paid by my Executors as soon
 possible after my Decease and in like manner a horse and a young mare
 I give to my beloved Daughter Grace Raisford five Cows & Calves.

in like manner a young Horse and a Mare I give to my beloved
 Daughter patience Raisford five Cows and Calves and likewise a
 Horse and a mare I give and Bequeath to my well beloved Daughter
 Elizabeth Raisford five Cows and Calves Likewise a Horse and a mare
 After the payment of all Legacies I will that all my Estates both
 Real and Personal be Appraised and Equally divided Amongst all my
 Children and Lastly to conclude I nominate and Appoint my wife Martha
 and my Son Philip Raisford my Son in Law John Pearson Executors and

my Blessed Saviour and Redeemer by whom alone I trust to receive the Pardon and Forgiveness of my Sins and to obtain Everlasting life and Salvation: And my Body at Death I commit to the Grave, to be decently and in a Christian like manner Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter named: And as to all my worldly Estate, I will and Ordain that the same shall be disposed of in manner and form following First, I will and desire that all my just Debts and Funeral Expences shall be well and truly paid, with all Convenient Speed after my Decease Item I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Brother William Allen, of St James Parish Goose Creek, Planter, the sum of ten Pounds Sterling; or the Value thereof, in Current Money, to Buy Mourning. Item I Give Bequeath and Devise unto my Dearly Beloved wife Ann Allen, for ever, to do and dispose thereof, at her Will and Pleasure; All the Rest and Residue of my Estate whatsoever, Real and Personal, and wheresoever the same ^{is} or shall be found: to her my said wife Ann Allen her Heirs and Assigns for ever. Lastly I nominate constitute and Ordain my Brother in Law John Scott of Charles Town aforesaid, Shop Keeper, whole and Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament.

I Benjamin Godin of South Carolina Gen: being now in health and of Sound and disposing Mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same yet Calling to mind the Uncertainty of this Trial and Tryal State And that all Flesh must yield unto Death I first and Principally Command my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my greater hoping for Mercy & Salvation in and thro' the Instruments meane of his Son Jesus Christ my Redeemer And my Body I Committe to the Earth to be decently Interred at the Discretion of my Exe^rc^t and Exe^rc^t hereinafter named And as for such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to Bestow Upon me I give and Bequeath the same as follows— In primitis I give and Bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Ann Godin the sum of twelve thousand pounds Current money of this Province to be paid her by my Exe^rc^t hereinafter named And also her Watch and Rings Together with my Coach and Two Chaises with the Several Horses Commonly Used in and Belonging to them and also all my Riding Horses Item I give and Bequeath unto my said loving wife the Use of the following Slaves Viz: Five men named Little Niga Matt Stafford Abram & Walley Two Boys named Caesar & Billy Nine Women named Phoebe Mally Juba Noll Doll Betty Bella and Sassa and one Negro Girl named Kate or Tub To have and to hold the said severall Slaves unto my said loving wife for and during the Term of her natural Life if she shall so long Continue a widow Item I give and Bequeath unto my said loving wife during the Term of her widowhood Aforesaid the free Use of all my Plantation Household Goods and Implements of Husbandry and Furniture whatsoever in Charles Town and at my Plantation in Goose Creek together Also with the free Use of all my Head Cattle Sheep and Hogs which are Upon my said Plantation Item it is my mind
