In the Name of God Amen the Seventh day of March in the year
 of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred forty & eight I Eliz^a Godwin, Widow
 of Ashley ferry in the Parish of St Andrews in Berkley County, being Sick in body
 but of Sound & perfect mind & understanding Thanks be to Almighty God for
 the same do make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form
 following that is to say First & principally I Give & Recommend my Soul into the
 hand of Almighty God that gave it & my body I Recommend to the Earth &
 to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors &
 as concerning such Temporal Estate as by the blessing of God I am now possessed
 of I give & bequeath in the manner & form following. Infirmities It is my Will
 & desire that all due Sums of money that I shall leave unpaid or
 stand indebted justly to any person, on the day of my decease, shall be well
 & truly paid. Item I Give & bequeath unto Thomas Radeliffe the Son of
 Thomas Radeliffe of St Philips in Charlestown, Tinner all my Right &
 property in the Lot & house No 3 at Ashley ferry to him & his heirs. Item
 I Give to my neice Mary Coffin a Negro wench named Dido, & the Cotton

bed & bedstead 6 Chains & Talle to She and her heirs for ever, & no ways to be
 sold by her or her husband, but to be for her Use & her heirs for ever. Item I
 Give unto Thomas Radeliffe Jun^r one Negro Boy named Andrew, & unto Elizabeth
 Radeliffe Jun^r one Negro Girl named Diana to thoy & there heirs forever
 Item I Give all the rest & remainder of my personal Estate to be divided Equally
 between Elizabeth Radeliffe Sen^r & Thomas Radeliffe Jun^r That is to say Negroes
 cattle, Stock household goods debts money & moveable Effects whatsoever, to thoy
 & their heirs forever Item I Constitute & Appoint my beloved friend Elizabeth
 Radeliffe Sen^r my Sole & Wholy Executrix of this my last Will & Testament
 And I do hereby Utterly disallow revoke & Disannul all & every other former
 a Testament Wills Legacies & bequests & Executors, by me in any wise before
 made In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this Seventh
 day of March one Thousand Seven Hundred & forty eight

 County in St Bartholomew Parish in the Province of South Carolina Being in
 Perfect Health (Blessed be God) has thought it proper & convenient to make
 and Constitute this my last will & Testament & desire that it may be Received as
 such by all People. Infirmities my will is that all the debts of the Estate & my Funeral
 Charges be first Paid. Item I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Cousin Hannah
 Murphy Out of that Estate Descending to me by my Father Joseph Andrew deceased
 One Thousand Pounds & one Girl called Senah to her & her heirs for ever,

Item I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Cousin Catherine Murphy Out of the Estate aforesaid the like Sum of One Thousand Pounds & one Negro Girl called Lucy to her & her Heirs for Ever. Item, I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Cousin Joseph Sealy all & singular the Remaining Part of my Estate Decended as aforesaid as well Goods & Chattles as Negroes & Money to him & his Heirs for Ever. Item, my Will also is that after the debts & Charges aforesaid be Paid then I Impower my Executors to pay the above Legacies as it can be made of my Plantation Each of them an Equal Share a Year till they be both Paid. Item, I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Cousin Elizabeth Sealy when she Arrives at the age of Twenty three One Thousand Pounds. Item, I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Cousin William Sealy when he Arrives at the age of Twenty one, One Thousand Pounds to him & his Heirs for Ever. Item I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Cousin Susannah Sealy at the age of Twenty One Thousand Pounds to her & her Heirs for Ever. Item my Will is also that my Executor hereafter mentioned be Carefull to execute my Father's Will in Respect to my Aunt Hannah Murphy as soon as they can or see it most convenient. I Appoint my Friend John Mitchell my Cousin Barah Martin & my Cousin Joseph Sealy to be Executors to this my last Will & Testament, my Will also is that the Negro Girl called Milley shall still continue in the Service of my Aunt Hannah Andrew and at her Death shall be the Property of my Cousin Joseph Sealy. my Will also is that no part of my Estate be Sold without Force In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this 9th day of July 1748

St. Bartholomew Parish in the Province & County aforesaid (Plantation) being
weak of body, but of perfect mind & memory; Thanks be to God for the same; Calling to
mind; the Mortality of my Body; and that it is appointed unto all men once to die;
do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament; that is to say, First of all &
principally; I Recommend my Soul into the hands of God who gave it; & my Body
to the Earth to be buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter mentioned;
Nothing doubting but I shall Receive the same again at the Resurrection of the Just;
by the mighty power of God; in & Through the merits of my blessed Redeemer Jesus
Christ; & as Touching such worldly Estate, as God has been pleased to Bless me
with in this life; I Give, Bequeath demise & dispose of as follows; Infirmus
It is my Will & desire that all money justly due to me be Collected as soon as
possible & that my just debts & Funerall Charges be first paid: & if there is not
a sufficiency to discharge all my just debts & Funerall Charges that then such a
part of my Estate as can be Best Spared ^{shall} be exposed to Sale; as will be
sufficient for a full discharge of all demands on my Estate; Item after my
debts be paid. I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Sister Martha Smith the full &
just Sum of Fifty Pounds Currency of the Province aforesaid to be paid to her as soon
as it can be made off the plantation. Item my Will & desire is that after my Estate
is Clear from all debts & demands; that it be fairly & equally divided into
three parts: and after such division the two third part of my Estate be be
put to use for the Benefit & behoof of my well beloved daughter Mary
Martin: & the use & benefit arising therefrom shall be applied to the schooling
relotting & bringing up of this my ~~and~~ ^{daughter} daughter & the principal of such two third
parts of my Estate be paid my daughter when she arrives to the age of Twenty one
years, or when she is lawfully married & then to be for her & her heirs & assigns forever
but if it should please God to Call her out of the world before she be lawfully
married that then & in such Case her portion of ^{which} I have left to her shall
