

More or less and also one third part of the stock of cattle that is on the said Plantation one Silver Tankard at the Death or Marriage of his Mother one Trustees man named Sam to him and his heirs forever my will and Desire is that when my son Capers is Building that he shall have the use or Laborer of the aforesaid Sam for nine months without Paying for Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Susannah Durand fifty Pounds Carolina Currency to be paid her by my Executors & Executor in twelve months after my Decease Item I Give and Bequeath unto my said son W^m Boone the Land I Purchased from Roger Moore Esq. on Shalloth River five Negroemen by name Bambia Jo, Essais Anthony Abraham Cooper Primus four boys by name Buckingham Fortune Little Joe and Jeffery two Women by name Cate & Nancy three Girls by name Rose Beck & Lucy them and their Increase one Silver watch at my Death one third part of my cattle on the Plantation Belonging to Thomas Boone Jr. one Silver Coffee pot at the death or Marriage of his Brother to him and his heirs forever Likewise three hundred Pounds Current Money to be payed him Immediately after my Decease Item I Give and Bequeath to my Capers Boone four negoe men by name Joney, James, Josey & Sharper four Women by name Bigg Hager Bensilla Moll & Betty four boys by name Jacob, Amos Benjamin & Summell three Girls by name Phiba Mariah & Hannah them and their Increase one third of my cattle on the Plantation belonging to Thos Boone Jr. and one Silver Bowl at the Death or Marriage of his Brother to him and his heirs forever Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son John Boone 1230 Acres of Land or more or less whereon I now live ~~Butting~~ and Bounding on Wapeckecon Creek on Mr. Joseph Allen's on Capt. Clement Lamprier on Mr. Thomas Hamlin on Col. George Benison on Andrew Rutledge Esq. and on one branch of Dawtaw Creek and in case of the Death of my son John Before the age of twenty one years or before he has a Lawfull Begotten heir then the Land I have hereunto given him shall go & Devolve unto my Son Capers and his heirs forever. Four Negroe men by name Tom, Dick, Will & John three women by name Little Hager, Diana & Jean three boys by name Frank Little Primus, Dave three Girls by name Hager, Peg & Black Hester them and their Increase two thirds of my ~~cattle~~ ^{stock} on this Plantation two Silver Pottingers Six Silver Spoons at the Death or Marriage of his Mother to him and his heirs forever. Item my will and Desire is that the rest of my household goods that is not

All Ready Disposed off be Equally Divided between my three sons William Capers and John Boone Item my will & Desire that the Land I Purchased of Belahs Hill Esq. Containing 762 Acres more or less and part of a Lot on Belahs Down Green that I Purchased of John Wetheringham to be sold and the moneys arising therefrom to be given to my son Capers Item my will and Desire is that after my debt & charge is paid out of my crops & moneys at Interest that my Executors & Executor shall pay fifty Pounds Carolina Currency to Defray the Charges of my son John Interest & the Remainder to be Equally Divided between my wife & my son Capers.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Grandson Thomas Boone one Negroe Girl named Jean her and her Increase to him and his heirs forever to be put into the Possession of his father for him Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Grandson Levi Durand one hundred Pounds Carolina Currency in twelve months after my Decease to be put into the hands of his father to be put at Interest for him

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Beloved wife and my son John my Periauger and Canoe for their Proper use Item my will and Desire is that in case my son ~~Wm~~ William my son Capers or my son John should die before the age of Twenty one Year or before they have a Lawfull Begotten heir that the Personal Estate herein given them or either of them be Equally Divided between my ~~Surviving~~ Surviving Children Lastly I do hereby constitute nominate & Appoint my Beloved wife to be my Executor and my Brother Richard Capers my Executor of this my Last will and Testament to Execute & fulfill all and every Article herein contained Allowing this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament Nevertheless it is my Will and Desire that in case of my wife marriage then and such case it is my Desire that my Brother Richard Capers shall have the full Power & Sole Management of my Estate given herein to my Children Signed Sealed Published

Given & life hoping for the Remission of all my sins in and through the Merits
 Death & Suffering of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ my body I give to the earth to
 be decently ~~buried~~ buried among my deceased friends at the discretion of my
 Executors and my worldly Estate I give in manner after mentioned Inprimis it is
 my will that before my Division of all or any part of my Estate that all my
 Just Dells & funeral Charges be paid & Satisfied I Give and Beise to my well beloved
 wife Mary Keating that Plantation or Lands where Mr. Isaac Peronneau
 now lives containing about Six Hundred & Seventy Acres of land more or less
 Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son Maurice Keating the Plantation I now
 live on which I Purchased of Mr. Job Rothmaller containing Five Hundred
 Acres of Land. I Give and Bequeath unto my Beloved wife Mary Keating
 and to my Son Maurice Keating all my Negroes, Horses, Cattle and other
 Moveables that I Possess in Goose Creek Parish to be Equally Divided between
 my said Wife & Son my will is that my said son Maurice should die before he
 arrives to the Age of twenty one years that I give to my son Sedgwick Lewis out of
 my said son parts one Negro fellow Valued at two hundred & fifty Pounds or two
 Hundred & fifty Pounds Lawfull Money my will is that all my Cattle &
 horses that I have over the Congaree River shall be Disposed of by my Execu^{rs}
 hereafter named the money arising therefrom to pay my Just Dells my will
 is that my son Maurice Keating shall die before he comes of age that the
 one half of his part of Negroes shall be Equally Divided between my three ~~children~~
 Sisters Ann Simmons Mary Allen and Rachel Gough my will is that the other
 half to go to my said wife Mary Keating my will is that my Brother
 Richard Gough after my Decease shall have the use of my Silver Mounted
 Pistols till my said son shall come of age which if he dies before then the
 said Pistols shall go to my said Brother Gough I Give to my Cousin Sedgwick
 Lewis my best Gun Lastly I Constitute & Appoint Mr. Richard Shingleton
 Mr. Richard Gough & Mr. Sedgwick Lewis Disannulling all wills
 formerly by me made Furthermore I do Impower my said Executors to
 make a Good Sufficient & Lawfull title for two Tracts of Land containing in
 the whole One thousand two hundred & twenty three Acres Situate on
 Wapsumsaw Swamp as Appears by the Platts which said two Tracts was sold
 by me to Sedgwick Lewis with the proviso he pays unto my Estate the sum of
 One thousand Pounds Lawfull money of South Carolina This I Declare to be
 my last will and Testament consisting of two sheets paper In Testimony
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Eighteenth day of
 December ~~1749~~ One thousand Seven Hundred forty nine

 the Province of South Carolina aforesaid Planter being in Good health of body & of Sound &
 Disposing mind & meaning thanks be to God but knowing the Uncertainty of human
 life do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form
 following that is to say First I Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God
 my Creator in hopes that through the Merits of my blessed Saviour & Redeemer Jesus
 Christ to Obtain Remission of my Sins my body I Commit to the earth to be buried
 at the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter named.

Inprimis it is my will and Beise that all my just Dells & funeral Expenses
 be duly paid & Satisfied by my Executors hereinafter mentioned

Item I Give and Bequeath all my Estate both real & Personal to my wife Sarah
 Fuller and my two Children Sarah & Nathaniel Fuller and tis my Desire that after
 my Dells are paid that all my Estate be sold by my said Executors and the
 money arising therefrom may be put out at Interest as soon as Possible for the
 Benefit of my two Children Sarah & Nathaniel and as my wife Sarah Fuller
 is now with Child tis my Intent & meaning that the said Child shall be Intitu-
 led to an Equal Proportion of my Estate with my said wife and two Children
 before mentioned should either of my said Children die before they arrive to the
 age of twenty one years or day of marriage then their part or Equal Proportion
 of my Estate to be Equally Divided amongst the Survivors but should my wife
 Sarah Fuller die before my said Children arrive at the age of twenty one years
 or day of marriage when their part or Portion of my Estate shall be paid to them
 then I Appoint my brother Benjamin Fuller to be Guardian or Trustee to my
 Children Lastly I Constitute & Appoint my said wife Sarah Fuller whole &
 Sole Executrix to this my last will and Testament In Witness Whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & Seal to this my last will this 28th day of Dec^r
 1749 Nathaniel Fuller (Ld)
