Item to my Brother John Scott whom I make Constitute & appoint as my sole Ex^{or} of this my last Will & Testament all the Remainder of my Estate Real & personal to this only proper use & behoof and I do hereby Revoke Revoke Disclaim & Disavow all former Wills & Testaments before this time, Ratifying and Confirming
