

In the Name of God Amen, I Paul Maryczek of Chara Town in Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina being in Health of Body & of Perfect Mind & Memory (Thanks be to God for the Same) but Calling to mind the Uncertainty of this Transitory Life, & knowing it is appointed all men once to die do make & declare these Presents to be & contain my Last Will & Testament in manner following (that is to say) First & Principally being Penitent & heartily Sorry for my Sins, I commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, in whom, & by whose Mercy I trust & Assuredly believe to be Saved & to enjoy Eternal Life, & my Body I commit to the Earth (from whence it was Taken) to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors & Executors hereinafter Named, & for the disposing of such Temporal Estate with which it hath Pleas'd God to Bless me, I do Give, Devise & bequeath the Same in manner & Form following, (that is to say) - In primis I will & Order that all my just Debts be paid & Discharged as Soon as conveniently may be after my Decease. Item I Ratify & Confirm the Joinder & Settlement which I have heretofore made on my Wife Catherine & every Clause Article & thing therein Contained, & for that Purpose I give Devise and bequeath (out of the money I have at Interest) the Sum of One thousand Pounds Proclamation Money to be paid to my said Wife Catherine for her Portion or Coynter by Settlements made by me upon her before her Marriage. Item I do hereby Devise, Authorize & Impower my Executors hereinafter Named, & the Survivors of them to Sell & Dispose of my Part of a Town Lot of Land Situate in Chara Town & Fronting on Broad Street, & also my Part of an Island near Port Royal. Item I give Devise & bequeath unto my dearly beloved Wife Catherine the Sum of Two thousand Pounds Current Money of this Province. Item I give & bequeath unto my said Dear Wife, my following Slaves, named Judy, Bawto, Dinah & Bide, to have & to hold the Same to my said Wife her Executors Administrators & Assigns forever. Item I Give & bequeath unto my said Dear Wife the Use & Occupation of my House & Land in Chara Town on which I now Live till my Daughter Charlot comes of Age or be married & also the Use of my Little Plantation on Chara Town Neck (which I Purchased from my Brother Is: Maryczek as Executor to my Fathers Will) till my Son Alex^r comes of Age Item I do hereby Order, Direct & Declare, that the Legacies & bequests herein before mentioned & intended for my said Wife, to be given & bequeathed, & shall be by her Accepted & Taken in Lieu & full Satisfaction of all Dowers & thirds which she is, or shall or may be intitled to after my Death, or in my Estate, & not otherwise, & in case she, or any other person or persons in her name or by her faculty, Consent or agreement shall Demand, or sue for any Dower or thirds out of, or in my Estate, then I do hereby Revoke the said bequests and Legacies

Legacies so intended for my said Wife, And I do hereby Give, Devise & bequeath the Same, to & among my Children, to be Equally divided Share & Share alike - Item I give Devise & bequeath unto my beloved Son Alexander my Plantation on Fosters Creek which I Purchased from Jo: Davis containing Eight Hundred & Eighty Acres of Land, & also my Plantation adjoining which I Purchased from Benj^m Smith Cont^g Three Hundred and Twenty five Acres of Land to have & to hold the same to him his heirs & Assigns forever. Item I give & bequeath unto my said Son Alexander my Little Plantation on Chara Town Neck which I Purchased from my Brother Isaac Maryczek as Executor to my Fathers Will & also three pieces or Lots of Land lying near the old Burying Ground distinguished by the Numbers Two, Ten & Twenty nine As appears by a certain Plat being Annexed to a Deed of Partition made & Executed between Isaac Maryczek, Paul Maryczek, Benj^m Maryczek & Stephen Maryczek & bearing Date the Eighteenth day of December Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred & Forty two; to have & to hold the said Little Plantation & three pieces or Lots of Land to him his heirs & Assigns forever Item I give & bequeath unto my said Son Alex^r the sum of Two thousand Pounds Current Money of this Province. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Charlot, the House & Lot where I now Live & also two pieces or Lots of Land distinguished by the Numbers Seven & Fifteen (as appears by the Above mentioned Plat & Deed of Partition) One of the said Lots lying at the West end of Broad Street containing Fifty feet Front & Two hundred & Twenty Eight feet Deep; & the other on Queen Street containing Fifty feet Front & Two hundred and twenty eight feet Deep; to have and to hold the said three Lots of Land to her & her heirs & Assigns forever & also, give & bequeath unto my said Daughter Charlot the Sum of Fifteen hundred Pounds Current Money of this Province. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Mary Three Pieces of Lots of Land distinguished by the Numbers Seventeen Twenty Two, & Twenty Seven, as appears by the Above mentioned Plat & Deed of Partition bearing date the Eighteenth day of December Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred & Forty two, the Lot Number Seventeen lying near the Work House is a Corner Lot on Queen Street & Maryczek Street containing Seventy feet Front & Two hundred & Sixty feet Deep, Number Twenty Two on Magazine Street containing One hundred & five feet Front & One hundred & five feet Deep; the other Lot Number Twenty Seven on Queen Street & Maryczek Street containing Ninety & One Hundred & five feet Front being a Corner Lot & Adjacent to the Lot Number Seventeen Ending in a Point of Marsh adjoining Burying Ground to have & to hold the said Three Pieces or Lots of Land to her & her heirs & Assigns forever And also I give & bequeath unto my said Daughter Mary the Sum of Fifteen hundred Pounds Current Money of this Province - Item

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Item if my Exors Judges it for the Interest of my Children to Dispose of all my Negroes & other of my Personal Estate I give them full Power so to do at any convenient time as they shall think proper, & the Money arising from such sale together with the Bonds above directed to be sold, I give devise & bequeath to & among my Children Alexander, Charles & Mary, to be Equally divided between them Share & Share alike by my Exors as they Respectively Attain their Ages of Twenty one Years; but in Case any of my said Children should dye before he she or they Attain his, her or their age of Twenty one years or day of Marriage my Mind & will is that the part or Share of them so dying shall go to, & be divided among the Survivors of them, & my Mind is that if my Daughters Marries, with the Consent of my Wife, or the Majority of my Exors, before their Age of Twenty one Years, that then they shall be Intituled to have & Receive their Respective Portions, upon such their Marriage, but if they Marry without such Consent they shall not be Intituled to Receive their Portion until their Respective Ages of Twenty one Years. Item I do Direct & Desire my Exors to pay out at Interest all such Money bequeathed to my said Children & arising from the Sale of my said Lands, Negroes & other of my Personal Estate & Requiring good Security for the same. Item my Will is & I here Recommend to my Exors not to Clear any Land whatsoever on my Plantation on Fosters Creek or to Cut any Timber or Trees more than is barely Required for Fencing & making Barsels for the use of the Crofs. Item I give & bequeath unto my Cousin Judith Gignilliat the Sum of One Hundred Pounds Lawful Money of this Province & also the like Sum I Give & bequeath unto her Sister Susannah Gignilliat. Item I give & bequeath unto M^{rs} Rene Ravel Seig^r the Sum of Seventy five Pounds to buy her a Suit of Mourning & the like Sum I give & bequeath unto Rene Ravel Jun^r for the same Purpose. Item I give & bequeath to the Church Wardens of the French Church the Sum of Fifty Pounds Lawful Money of this Province, for the Poor of the said Church. Item if it should please God to Take away all my Children before they come to their Age of Twenty one Years or be married; my Will is that my dear Wife if living shall have One Thousand Pounds Proclamation money & to my Brother Isaac Mazyck (after the decease of my said Wife) to have my little Plantation on Charles Town Creek, & also the Lot of Corners on Queen Street & Mazyck Street to have & to hold the said little Plantation & Lot wth 17 to him his heirs & Assigns forever. And to my Brother Stephen Mazyck to have

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the Lot wth 2 & 29 on Broad Street adjoining his Lots at the West End of the said Street to have & to hold the said two Lots wth 2 & 29 to him his heirs & Assigns forever, & to my nephew John Gendron to have the Lot wth 15 to have & to hold the Lot wth 15 to him his heirs & Assigns forever. The Remains of my Real Estate that is to say my Plantation on Fosters Creek, & my Lots in Char^l Town to be divided Equall between all my Brothers, to have & to hold the said Lands & Lots to them & their heirs & Assigns forever, And my Personal Estate to be Equally divided between all my Brothers & Sisters, that is to say Isaac Mazyck, Ben^g Mazyck, Stephen Mazyck, Mariam Godin, & to the Children of my late Sister Gendron as her part. And here I would Recommend it to all my Children that as they would Expect & have the Favour & Protection of Heaven & the Countenance of all good men, that they would be Dutiful & Obedient to their Mother & Kind & Affectionate one to another, & that they would by all Offices of Friendship & Brotherly Love, - Abish & Support one another; in all Cases of need, & at all other times - And Lastly I do hereby Nominat, Constitute & Appoint my dear Wife (during her Widowhood) & my Loving Brothers, Isaac Mazyck, Stephen Mazyck, & Rene Ravel Jun^r Executors & Exors of this my Last Will & Testament and Guardians to my said Children, hereby Revoking & making Null & Void all former & other Wills by me heretofore made; declaring these Presents to be & contain, my Last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this twelfth Day of December 1746
