for the Same do make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in -
manner & Form following Viz: First & Principally I commend
my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God and my Body to the Earth to
be Buried in a Christian like Manner at Discretion of my Dear Wife
in Hopes of a joyful Resurrection and to Receive Pardon for all my Sins
in & through the Merits of our Blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
and As touching such Worldly Estate Wherein it hath Pleased God to -
Bless me With all I give Devise & dispose of as follows Viz: I will
and Define that all my Just Debts & Funeral Charges be first paid
Discharged and Satisfied by my Loving Wife Marter Steale -
First I give & Bequeath unto my Dear & Loving Wife Marter Steale
Two Thousand Pounds in Gold One hundred & Eighty Spanish Dollars
One Negro Woman by the name of Little Tea, e Silver Tankard
Ten Tablespoons of Silver One Silver Triller, Punch Strainer
of Silver, One Silver Ladle Six Tea Spoons One ces One Tea -
Strainer, all the Bonds Notes and Book Debts that are due to me to her
and to her disposal, Secondly: I give and Bequeath to my Daughter
Ann Withengal the house and Land Whereon she lives for her Life
and After her Decease to my Grand Daughter Nancy Withengal
I Likewise Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Ann Withengal
One Hundred and Eighty Spanish Dollars to her & her disposal -
Thirdly I give and Bequeath to my Grand Daughter the House &
Land & Out Houses Whereon I now live Ten Silver Spoons One
Silver Salver One Silver Punch Strainer One Large Copper Kettle
One Negro man Jack a man Peter a man Dick a Boy Ned a negro

shall first Happen it is my Will that my Wife Marter Steale shall be
and remain on the House that I now Live on Receive all Advantages of
the House and Yard untill my Grand Daughter be Sixteen years of Age
or Married and that my Spouse Marter Steale shall maintain
Educate and Bring up my said Grand Daughter at her own Expense
I Likewise give and Bequeath to my Wife Marter Steale all the
Remainder of my Goods and Houseful Furniture untill my said
Grand Daughter Arrive to the Age of Sixteen or be married and if it
should Please God to take my Grand Daughter out of this World
before the Age of Sixteen or before marriage then it is my Will that
all the Above mentioned Left to my Grand Daughter shall Return
to my Wife Marter Steale And I do hereby nominate and Appoint
my Dear & Loving Wife Marter Steale to be my Sole heir and -
Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament hereby Revoking -
Disannulling and making Void all Other Will and Testaments
by me at any time heretofore maid In Witness Whereof I have to
this my Last Will and Testament Set my hand and Seal this Thirsd
Day of February in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven
Hundred and Forty Seven
