

In the name of God Amen This Thirteen day of December 1749 I Anthony Atkinson of the Parish of Prince George in Beaven County in the Province of South Carolina Planter being sick and weak of Body but of Perfect mind & memory Praised be Almighty God but calling to mind the mortality of the body & knowing that is Appointed for all men once to die do make & Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner & form following that is to say Principally and first all I Recommend my soul to God that gave it and my Body I Commit to the Earth to be Buried at the Discretion of my Exec^r: hereafter named and as to my Worldly Goods & Estate I Give Devise & Dispose of the same in manner and form following

Imprimis I Give and Bequeath to my son George Atkinson ~~& to his heirs forever~~ one Town Lot in Georgetown known in the Plan or modell of the s^t George Town by the number (129) and all my household Goods to my s^t son George Atkinson & to his heirs forever Item I Give and Devise to my Grand Son Anthony Mitchell and to his heirs forever one Town Lot in George Town known in the Plan or modell of the s^t George Town by the number One hundred & thirty Item I Give and Devise unto my son George Atkinson and to my son in Law Thomas Mitchell both whom I hereby Appoint Exec^r: of this my Last will & Testament all & Singular my real and Personal Estate / Except as above bequeathed / Consisting of Lands wheresoever Situate that I am Possessed of at the time of my Decease also all my negro Slaves next Battles horses & Horses &c or Whatever Belongeth or in any wise appertaineth to me at the time of my Decease as afores^d and I do hereby Give full and absolute Power & Authority to my s^t son George Atkinson and to my s^t Son in Law Thomas Mitchell or the Survivor of them my s^t Exec^r: to sell & Dispose of all or any part, or Part of my Lands and to sell and Dispose of all or any part of my Personal Estate and the money arising thereby to be applied towards the Payment of my Debts or otherwise if my s^t Exec^r: or Exec^r: shall think fit to Continue the Slaves or any Part of them on the Plantation they have hereby full Power & Authority so to do: Provided that my Creditors are Satisfied and Whatsoeuer shall remain of all my Real & Personal Estate after the Payment of my Debts I Give and Bequeath to my s^t son George Atkinson and to my s^t Grandson Anthony Mitchell to be Equally Divided between them Share & Share alike to them and to their heirs or Assigns forever And Lastly Do nominate & Appoint my said son George Atkinson and my son in Law Thomas Mitchell both of Beaven County in the Province of South Carolina Exec^r: of this my Last will & Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow Revoke & Disannul all and every other former Testament Wills Legacies & Bequests & Exec^r: by me in any wise named Willed or Bequeathed Ratifying & Confirming This and no other to be my

Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the day & year above written

In the name of God amen I Andrew Warnock of Berkley County in the Province of South Carolina Planter being sick in body but of sound disposing mind and memory Blessed be God for the same do make and ordain this my Last will & Testament in manner & form following First & Principally I Command my soul into the hand of Almighty God hoping through the Satisfaction & Merits of my only saviour & Dear Redeemer Jesus Christ to have full & free Parson of all my sins and to inherit Eternal Life my body I Commit to the Earth to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my Exec^r: and Exec^r: hereafter named and Touching such Temporal Estate as hath pleased God of his infinite mercy to bless me with I Give & Dispose thereof as follows Imprimis I Will that all my just Debts and funeral Charges & Expenses be first Paid Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Loving wife Tharmarson five Slaves by name Dinah Wacowaw, Peter, Guinea Peter, Harry, & Cuffe and one Ring horse named Pacotl with a Side Saddle and also to have the Sixth part of what Income may be made on my Plantation during my Widow & Know Longer & my Meaning is that what Slaves I have herein Given her shall be Included with the rest of my Slaves to Work for the Maintaining of my Children During her Widower hood and she to draw but the Sixth Part of the whole Income Yearly during her Widower hood But I do hereby Declare that the Several Legacies Gifts & Devises by me herein bequeath unto any s^t wife are as Given unto her and are meant & Intended to be in full Satisfaction and bare of all such Dower and title of Dowers and Interest & Customy Part Share or thirds of my real or Personal Estate which she can or may claim by any Right or title or Customy whatsoever Item if any of my Children to whom is hereafter herein Given & Devised should die before they come to age to Inherit & have no Issue then I order that their Share or Part Given & Bequeath real or Personall to be Equally Divided and Shared among the rest of my surviving Children

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Tharmarson one Negro girl named Phibey with her hereafter Increase to her and her heirs forever
Item Whereas my wife Tharmarson is now Begaynt with Child if in Case it shoud be a daughter
