 all the Remainder of my Estate of what nature or kind soever
 it may be or whereever it may be found within the
 Province of South Carolina at the time of my Dec^d by her
 freely to be possessed and Enjoyed Lastly I do hereby Appoint
 Nominate & Constitute my niece Eliz^a Hays Esq^r & M^r. Henry
 Wth Julian & James Maxwell Esq^rs of this my Last Will & Testament
 & do hereby Revoke & Disannul all other former will or wills
 Testament or Testaments by me heretofore made Ratifying &

 Bequeath to Ann Milner Ten pounds as also to her son Jth Milner five
 pounds Curr^t money of this Province I also Give and Bequeath to my
 Beloved friend John Fry Ten pounds Curr^t money of this Province
 and all the Residue & Remainder Part of my Personal Estate I Give
 and Bequeath to my Eldest Son Samuel Jennings whom I
 appoint whole & sole Ex^{or} of this my Last Will & Testament
 hereby Revoking Disannulling and making void all other
 wills & Testaments by me at any time heretofore made Ratifying
 Acknowledging Declaring & Confirming this & no other to be & Contain
 my Last Will & Testament in Witness whereof I the said Samuel
 Jennings to this my Last will & Testament have hereunto set
 my hand & Seal the 8th day of Septem^r in the year of our
 Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty three

 Last will & Testament in manner following first I Recommend my
 soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it in hope of
 a Joyful & Blessed Resurrection at the Last day by and thro' the
 merits & Intercession of my ever dear & blessed Saviour & Redeemer
 Jesus Christ Amen and as for what Temporal Estate it hath pleased
 Almighty God to bless me with I Give Devise & Bequeath in manner &
 form following VIZ: I will that my just debts & funeral
 Expenses be first paid & discharged Then my will is that my Loving
 wife Susannah shall have the use of the plantation that I now
 live on & the buildings thereon During the time that she shall
 Remain my widow & no longer Then I Give Devise & Bequeath unto
 my Loving Son John Three hundred Acres of Land lying & being
 in St. James's Parish Grove Creek one hundred acres of which is land that I
 had from Mr. John Stone and the other two hundred acres to be taken out of the
 plantation or tract of Land I now live on that is to say such a part of
 my Plantation as shall be most contiguous & convenient to & for the
 above mentioned one hundred acres of Land that I had from the said
 John Stone which I leave to the discretion of my Executors hereinafter
 after named to say of in such manner as they shall think most
 proper & convenient and which said quantity or parcels of Land I Give
 to him my said Son John to be for him his heirs & assigns forever
 Then I Give Devise and Bequeath unto my Loving Son Thomas all
 the Remaining part of that Plantation or tract of Land I now live on
 being five hundred and fifty Acres with all the Buildings thereon
 as also the Land I lately bought from Peter Gurin being between
 twenty & forty Acres or thereabouts as also one hundred feet square
 of Land at a place commonly known by the name of Mill
 Creek all which said tracts or parcels of Land I Give to him my
 said Son Thomas to be for him his heirs & assigns forever
 Then I will that my family Warrt (that I took out some time past)
 be left to the discretion of my Exors. hereinafter named to act
 with in such manner as they shall judge to be most proper
 & beneficial for the Interest of my wife & children Then I Give
 Devise & Bequeath unto my Loving Daughter Ann Bradford
 fifteen pounds current Money to buy her a Mourning
 Ring Then my will is that all the Remaining
 Estate both Real & Personal whatsoever lying or being
 within this Province or Elsewhere be Equally divided between

& amongst my Loving wife Susannah my two Sons Thomas &
 John & my four Daughters Alice Esther Susannah & Mary
 (Excepting only and in is my will that whereas my Daughter
 Alice has two Slaves by name Sabina & Lido which were given
 her by her Grand father Stone that she shall have an equal share
 of my Estate y^e will make her an Equal Share with my wife
 and the Rest of my Children Including the Value of the said
 two Slaves by name Sabina & Lido at the time she shall
 Arrive of age to Receive her share) and which I Give to my wife
 my two Sons & my four Daughters to them their heirs
 & assigns forever Then I will that if Either of my two
 Sons shall die before they arrive to the age of twenty one
 years or have Lawful Issues that then the Land herein
 given to him shall go to the survivor to be for him his
 heirs & assigns forever and in case both my Sons
 should die that then the Land given to them shall
 go to & be Equally divided amongst my four Daughters
 that is to say, Alice Susannah Esther & Mary and
 in case any of my said Children should die before
 they arrive to the ages hereunto mentioned and that
 part or share that they now to have had of my
 Personal Estate shall be Equally divided amongst
 my wife & the surviving part of my Children and
 my will further is y^t no divisions shall be made
 of my Estate but at such times as my Children
 Respectively Arrive to the ages hereunto ment^d
 Then my will is that my sons shall

be twenty & one y^e & Decided at age
 be Seventeen y^e Daughters

 after named shall
 be nominate
 and my Loving friends Roger Saunders & Charles
 Parker wth my Loving wife Susannah to be Executors

& Land Situate on the west side of Church Street in Charles
Town Bequeathed to me by my Uncle W^m. B^o. Savage Merchant
dey after the widowhood or Decease of my Aunt Martha
Savage the widow of my said Uncle together with all
Houses out houses Edificies Buildings Hereditaments & Appur^{ts}
therunto Belonging and for want of heirs of the Body of my
said Brother Jeremiah to my Brother Th^o. Savage and to the
heirs of his body lawfully Begotten for ever & in Def^{ty}
to be & Right here

said Brother Jeremiah after the
Death my negro Slave named
I unto my father Th^o. Savage
only of Smith Carolina if he
be living at the time of my Decease but if he be dead I Give the
said one thousand pounds unto my mother Elizabeth Savage her
Exec^{rs} Admors & Assigns for ever Item I Give & Bequeath unto my
Aunt Martha Savage the sum of five hundred pounds
current money also I Give to my said Aunt the use of

my negro Slave named August during his widowhood I Give
I Give & Bequeath unto Th^o. Pickering three hundred pounds
current money Item I Give & Bequeath unto Christiana Haggan
three hundred pounds current money Item I Give to the wife
of my Brother John Savage Ten Shillings to buy a Ring and all the
rest and Residue of my Estate of what nature & kind the same
maybe I Give and Bequeath unto Father Thomas Savage my
Brothers John Savage Ephraim Savage & Th^o. Savage Jun^r. Hannah
Pickerson Martha Savage & Joseph Pickering to be equally divided
between them Share & Share alike and I hereby nominate
& appoint the said John Savage & Joseph Pickering Executors
of this my last will & Testament. I do said John Savage to
Settle & Regulate all the Estate Bequeathed me by my said
uncle and all other Concerns betwixt us & the said Joseph
Pickering to Settle all the Affairs of the Partnership of Savage
& Pickering as soon as Possible and whatever share & Interest
shall appear I am Intituled to from the said Partnership
to pay into the hands of my Brother John Savage to be
distributed & Provided as before mentioned and I do
hereby Revoke all former will & Wills by me at any time
heretofore made declaring this only to be my last will & Testament
Also it is my will that my sister Elizabeth Savage be Intituled
and have and receive & I do hereby give unto Th^o. Edg. Savage an
Equal part & proportion of the Residuary part of my Estate as afo^r
Equal with my father Brothers Hannah Pickerson Martha
Savage & Joseph Pickering In Witness whereof I have hereunto
Set my hand & seal the fourth day of October in the year of
our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & fifty
