 of Dried Plants as well as other natural Rarities my further
 will and desire is that they be packed up in a box and be
 sent to my good friend Dr John Frederick Gronovius at Leyden
 in Holland to be made what use of he shall think
 proper

 but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty
 power of God and as touching such worldly Estate whereunto it hath pleased

 the following manner & form I Impower that my debts and funeral
 Charges be paid out of my Estate Real & personal

Item to my Brother Alexander fifty pounds that is to say out of
 the money he already owes me and the Remainder of a Stock of
 neat cattle and if it be more then the Value of said money
 he may have it if less he must be contented
 Item to my Brother John Scott whom I make Constitute
 & appoint as only & Sole Ex^{or} of this my last Will & Testa-
 ment all the Remainder of my Estate Real & personal
 to this only proper use & behoof and I do hereby
 Revoke Revoke, Disclaim & Disavow all former Wills &
 Testaments before this time, Ratifying and Confirming
