

In the name of God Amen I William Allen of Goosecreek in the Province of South Carolina Planter being in Perfect health and of Sound & Disposing mind & Memory do make Publish & Declare these Presents to be and Contain my Last Will and Testament in form following that is to say First & Principally I do Command my Soul into the hands of Almighty God the Author & Giver of Life hoping for the Remission of all my sins in and through the merits Death & Passion of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ my body I Give to the earth to be Buried at the Discretion of my Executrix and Exec<sup>x</sup>s hereinafter named and as for my Worlly Estate I Give and Dispose thereof as follows Inprimis it is my Will that my Execut<sup>x</sup> or Exec<sup>x</sup>s hereafter mentioned & Appointed or the Survivor of them do sell and Dispose of my Plantation called Gallon Hill Containing 760 acres of Land Aqueable to the Inclosed Lott thereof Subscribed with my name for which Purpose I do hereby Give unto them or the Survivor of them full Power & Authority to make and Execute Proper Conveyances & Assurances in Law and the moneys Arising from the sale thereof I do order to be Applied in Discharge of my Just & Lawfull debts and the Overplus if any therebe shall be Accounted Part of my Personall Estate hereinbefore Disposed of Item all that my Plantation called Thorough Goods Containing 1270 Acres of Land Situate in Goosecreek & Boundling as is Represented by a plott thereof Inclosed & in me Subscribed I Give and Devise unto my Loving wife Mary to have and to hold the same and all the Appurtenances therunto Belonging unto my said wife Mary for and During the Term of her Natural life and after her Decease I Give and Devise the same unto my Daughter Elizabeth to have & to hold the same unto her and her heirs forever Item I Give and Devise unto my Said wife Mary that lott of Land in Shcalestown Known by the number 22 which I Bought of Mr Harvey to have and to hold the same unto her and her heirs forever I Give and Bequeath unto my Said wife Mary her Exec<sup>x</sup>s Admirs & Apeigns forever my Chaise & Chaise horse together with an Equal moiety or half part of all my Negroe Mullatto Mustes or Indian Slaves which I am Possesed of or any use Intituled unto and one Moiety or half part of all my Plate Household Goods Stock Books Horses Mares sheep hoggs & heat cattle and all other my Personall Estate of what Denomination soever Together also with a Negroe wench named Betty and her Increase which formerly Belonged to Mr. W<sup>m</sup> Cunn of Stons to have and to hold the same unto my said wife Mary and to her Executors Admirs and Apeigns forever Item I Give and Devise unto my said Daughter Elizabeth all that my Plantation & premises called old barnes and all & Singular the rest and Residue of my lands

Juraments Hereditaments whatsoever to have and to hold the same unto her & her heirs & Apeigns forever Provided Nevertheless and it is my will that my sd wife Mary shall have the free use & Enjoyment of all the Pine Lands Adjoining to the said Plantation called old barnes for and During the Term of her Natural life And I do hereby Give and Bequeath unto my d<sup>t</sup> Daughter Elizabeth all that Remaining moiety or half part of all my said Slaves Plate Household Goods Stock and other Personall Estate whatsoever not hereinbefore Disposed of to have and to hold the same unto her my said Daughter & her Ex<sup>x</sup>s Admirs & Apeigns forever but in case my said Daughter shalld happen to die before she Arrive at the age of Twenty one years or day of marriage then all the Estate both real & Personall which is herein a hereby Diversed or Bequeathed unto my said Daughter Elizabeth I do hereby fully and Absolutely Give Devise and Bequeath unto my said wife Mary to have and to hold the same unto her & her heirs Exe<sup>x</sup>s Admirs & Apeigns forever Item it is my Will that as soon as conveniently may be after my Death and Equal and Just Division of my said Personall Estate bequeathed in moiety as aforesaid shall be made by lotts in Such manner as my Executrix & Executors shall Direct and that Part or Share thereof which shall fall to my said Daughter Elizabeth I Desire my said Execut<sup>x</sup> & Exe<sup>x</sup>s or the Survivor of them to Distribute in such manner as they shall Judge most for the Interest of my said Daughter until she shall Arrive at the age aforesaid or day of marriage Item I Give unto my Brother John Allen a Suit of Mourning value £50 Curr. together with a Mourning Ring of value of £5 curr<sup>s</sup> Item I Give unto my friends Mr. Richard Shingleton of Goose Creek and Mr. Gabriel Marignault and to each of them a Suit of Mourning & a Mourning ring Lastly I do hereby Constitue my said wife Mary Guardian of my said Daughter & Execut<sup>x</sup> of this my Will and I do appoint my Said Friends Richard Shingleton & Gabriel Marignault Executors thereof hereby Revoking all former & other Wills by me at any time heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this twenty fourth day of March anno Domini 1747 in the twenty first year of his Majesties Reign Willm Allen AD
