Declare that it is the true Intent and Meaning of this my Last will + Testament

for this my Last will + Testament to sell and Dispose of all or any part
of my Estate both real + Personall and each of my Childrens Portion or Dividend
is sold as aforesaid the Proceeds to be put out at Interest and to Apslyed to the
