of South Carolina widow being very sick & weak of Body but of Perfect mind mind
& memory thanks be to God for the same but calling to mind the Mortality of my body &
Knowing it is Appointed for all men once to die do make & Ordain this my Last &
Testament in manner & form following that is to say Principally & first of all
I Recommend my Soul into the hands of God that made it and my body to the
Earth to be buried in a Decent & Christian like Manner at the Discretion of my Exors* here
after named Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection to Receive the same
by the Almighty Power of God and as touching such Worldly Goods wherewith it hath
Pleased God to bless me in this life I Give Devise & Bequeath the same in
manner & form following Inprimis I Will & Require that all my just
Debt's Legacies & funeral Expences to be first paid as soon as Possible after my de-
cease

I Give and Bequeath to my son Josias Dupe my Diamond Ring
I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Eliz^t Porcher one negroe Girl named Diana &
my hand in hand Ring. Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Carolin
Dupe one mistee Girl named Lezette a set of Silver tea Spoons my Wedding Ring
a new Cedar Table & a Chest of Drawers Item I Give and Bequeath to my Grand
Daughter Jane Dupe a Mourning ring not exceeding Twenty Pounds

Item I Give and Bequeath to my two Grand Daughters Martha & Catherine Porcher
each of them a Mourning ring not exceeding Twenty Pounds each Item my Will
& Desir Pleasure is that the Remainder of my Personall Estate shall be sold &
the Money arising therefrom to be Equally Divided between my Son Josiah
Dupe my Daughter Jane Eliz^t Dupe my Daughter Magdaline Gignilliat &
my Daughter Martha Porcher my Daughter Eliz^t Porcher and my Daughter
Carolyn Dupe but in case my Daughter Magdaline Gignilliat shall Inherit

Judith & her two Children named Sabina & Priscilla that then my said Daugh-
ter Magdaline Gignilliat shall deduct the amount of the said Inheritance
of her part or Share so left to be Equally Divided Between my said son Josias Dupe

Eliz^t Porcher my Daughter Carolyn Dupe Item my will and Desire is that my

Seipio for my Daughter Jean Dupe Item my will and Desire is that all my household goods
shall be Equally Divided between my son Josias Dupe my Daughter Jane Eliz^t Dupe
many Magdaline Gignilliat Martha Porcher Elizabeth Porcher and my Daughter Carolyn Dupe
Lastly I Nominate & Appoint my Son In Law Misses Abraham Dupe and Isaac
Porcher to my whole & sole Exors* of this my last will & testament and I do hereby
utterly Disallow Revoke & Disannull all and every other former Wills Testaments or
Bequests whatsoever Ratifying & Confirm this and no other to be my last Will & Testament
In witness I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 10th day of August 1748 and in the
Twenty first year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Grace of God King
of Great Britain France & Ireland Defender of the faith &c

In The name of God Amen December 26. 1748 I William Porter Seawea Parish of
Christ Church, County of Berkley South Carolina being in good health of Body & of Perfect
mind & memory Glory to God in ye highest I do make Constitute & Appoint this to be my last Will
& Testament Viz:

Inprimis I Recommend my Body to the earth to be decently interred at ye discretion of my
Exors* hereafter mentioned in hope of a blessed Resurrection to life everlasting my soul I Recom-
mend into the hand of God who gave it in hope of obtaining eternal happiness in his favour
through Christ by his holy Spirit As to what Worldly Estate is hath pleased ye Absolute Owner
& Supreme Governor of the Universe in his holy & wise & Powefull Providence graciously to
Give I dispose of it in following manner Viz:

First I Will that my funeral charges and all my just debts be paid & discharged
before any Division of my Estate hereafter mentioned be made & ye Division is as followeth
Viz I Give and Bequeath to Sarah Porter my wife all my household Goods & every
part & parcel thereof to be at her Disposing I will that the Disposse of my library Books
to any Minister she Pleaseth

Item I Give & Bequeath to the said Sarah Porter my wife all my Battle Young & Old
Great & Small together with Silver (if any there be) Silver Spoons Tea Spoons to her her
Disposse Item I Give & Bequeath to my said Wife Sarah Porter, all the debts if any there be
due to my Estate

Item I Will if my wife Sarah Porter have this Plantation I now live upon in Seawea
Parish

of Christ Church County of Berkley Containing two hundred and twenty five Acres of land together with the Dwelling house & all Appurtenances therunto belonging to his upon During his natural Life Item I Give and Bequeath to my said wife Sarah Porter all my negroes that are not here named or given away by name in this my Last & Testament to be at her Disposing with an Exception hereafter mentioned Viz: & her Disposing some of them to whom I direct at her Decease Item I Give and Bequeath this tract of Land I now lie upon in Seaville Containing two hundred and twenty five Acres of Land to Robert Murril Jun^r Son of Robert Murril Sen^r who was brought up in my family to him & the legitimate heirs of his body forever after the Decease of Sarah Porter my said wife Item I Give and Bequeath to Thos^r Todd Joiner who served his time with Capt^r Blith a tract of Land Containing four hundred Acres Situate on Wankhamaw River above ye Township in Braven County Prince of Prince George botting & bounding to the northward on two hundred Acres of Land formerly in my Possession but now in the Possession of Joseph Moody Murril in Leburnestown purchased by Virtue of Capt^r Wm^r Hendricks family Warrant & in his name and made over to me by Lease & Release I say the said tract of Land I Give to the said Thos^r Todd his heirs & Apigons forever Item I Give and Bequeath to Sam^r Grier Weaver and Planter in the Township of Wacchamaw a tract of Land Containing three hundred & fifty Acres purchased by the family Warrant of Sarah Hooker Widow & in her name & Legally Conveyed to me by Lease and Release lying in Braven County botting & Bounding Southwest on Wacchamaw Township to as the Plat Annexed to the Deed given by the Hon^r Thos^r Braughton Gover^r cloth Sheut I say the said tract of Land I Give and Bequeath to the said Sam^r Grier his heirs & Apigons forever Item I Will: Give and Bequeath to Anne Grier wife of the above named Sam^r Grier Three hundred Acres of my Plantation in the Township of Wacchamaw lying and Situate in ye Part of the Plantation wherein the said Sam^r Grier lies to her and her legitimate heirs of her body forever & in case of the failure of such heirs I Give and Bequeath the said Three hundred Acres of Land to my legal heir Item I Give & Bequeath to Samuel Porter the Remaining four hundred Acres of the said Plantation in Wacchamaw Township to him and the legitimate heirs of his body forever.

of the said Anne Grier to her and the legitimate heirs of her body forever as also a negroe boy named Peter to her the said Ann Grier and the legitimate heirs of her body forever Item I Will Give & Bequeath to Sam^r Porter a negroe man named Romeo a negroe woman named Kate with all her Issue after she is in the Possession of the said Sam^r Porter I Give also to the said Sam^r Porter a negroe girl named Amorette to him & his heirs forever Item I Will Give and Bequeath to my said wife Sarah Porter all my other negroes that are not given away by name in this my Last Will & Testament to be at her Disposing Exception Presently mentioned Viz: I Will give & Bequeath to the above named Robert Murril two negroe boys Viz: Lemback & Jack to him & his heirs forever after the Decease of Sarah Porter my said wife Item I Give and Bequeath to Ann Huggins Daughter of George Huggins and who is housed in my house Harring Melinda & Satyan with all their Issue to her and her heirs forever after the Decease of my wife Sarah Porter and in case of the Death of the said Anne Huggins before the Decease of Sarah Porter my wife I will that those negroes with their Issue at the Disposal of Sarah Porter my wife Item I Give to the said Anne Huggins a negroe boy named Little Scipio to her & her heirs forever but in case of the Death of the said Anne Huggins before the death of Sarah Porter my wife I will that Little Scipio be at my wife's Disposal and for the Execution of this my Last Will & Testament I will and Constitute my good Neighbour & friend Capt^r William Hendrick Esq^r my Exoy^r & my said wife Sarah Porter Exoy^r & do hereby Utterly Disallow Revoke & Disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills: Legacies & Exoy^rs: by me in any wise before named Willed & Bequeathed Ratifying & Confirming this and no other to be my Last Will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal
