the Rest, Residue and Surplusage of my Estate, I give devise and bequeath,
unto my Son in Law, the said Charles Stevenson, his Executors, Administrators
and Assigns forever. Lastly I hereby nominate, constitute and
Appoint my said Son in Law Charles Stevenson, and loving Friend
Mr Edward Newville Merchant to be my Executors, and my said Daughter
Mary Stevenson to be Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, and
do hereby utterly Revoke, and make null and void all other Wills and Testaments
by me heretofore made or declared. In witness whereof I the said Peter

and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided amongst the Remainder
of my Children, share and share alike, to them & their Heirs forever. Item,
I do hereby nominate, Constitute and Appoint Messrs Isaac & Benjamin Mayhew
to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hoping and desiring that
they will see the same executed according to the Tenor & best construction of the
same. Lastly I do Revoke, and Null and declare to be Void and of None Effect
all former Wills or Wills, Testaments or Testaments heretofore by me made And
