Item all the Best, Residue and Surplusage, of my Estate, I give devise and bequeath unto my Son in Law, the said Charles Stevenson, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns forever. Lastly I hereby nominate, constitute and Appoint my said Son in Law Charles Stevenson, and loving Friend & Mr Edward Newville Merchant to be my Executors, and my said Daughter Mary Stevenson to be Executrix of this my said last Will and Testament, and do hereby utterly Revoke, and make null and void all other Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made or declared. And as for what temporal Estate it hath pleased God to bestow upon me in this World, I do

Give, Devise, Bequeath and Dispose of the same as is hereby & herein particularly set down, mentioned and expressed. I therefore my Will and Devise is That all my just Debts be fully satisfied contained and paid. Item, I give Devise and Bequeath unto my Son John Sandford Chinnors, my now dwelling Plantation, or four hundred Acres thereof, with the settled part of the same, To him and his Heirs forever in full of my part or Residue of the same. Item my Will and pleasure is, that after my just Debts be fully satisfied and paid, that the Remainder of my Estate both real and personal be and the money arising therefrom, to be equally divided amongst the Remainder of my Children, share and share alike, to them & their Heirs forever. Item, I do hereby nominate, Constitute and Appoint Messrs Isaac & Benjamin Mapp to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hoping and desiring that they will see the same executed according to the Tenor & best construction of the same. Lastly I do Revoke, and Null and declare to be Void and of None Effect all former Wills or Wills, Testaments or Testaments heretofore by me made and do Declare these presents to be my last Will and Testament and none other. In Testimony whereof, I have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand & Seal this sixteenth day of March, One thousand seven hundred & fifty nine
