In the Name of God Amen I Abraham Jordan being Sick of age
but of sound understanding & memory do make of my last will and Testament
as follows first I give my soul to God who gave it me & some body to be buried in a
Christian & decent Manner according to discretion of my Executors here after mentioned
And as for such worldly goods as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this world a
Twile and bequeath as followeth First I leave unto my Oldest daughter Mary £⁵ Sterling
with the me of a Wench she hath already got And all the debts her
husband owes me Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Jean negro
Village & as much Money as will buy a Little negro Wench with the boy she
hath already got And all the debts her husband owes me Item I give and
bequeath unto my Daughter Margaret £250 of this Currency and no more
Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth one Negro Wench to the
negro wench she has already got Item I give & bequeath unto my Grand
son Abraham Bellemee one Negro Boy named Friday those above named
shall never come to any other division than what is already done

I now will that after all my debts and Funeral Charges are paid that the
Remainder of my Estate both real & personal be disposed of in the following
manner First I leave unto my only son Joseph all my Lands and to his
Lawfull Heirs proceeding from his body and none else Except the use of
my Dwelling House to my wife Mary during her life with as much Land
as her Negroes here after named shall be able to work, and no other such
House as are necessary And as to my negroes I will that my Son Joseph
shall have half of all those that belong to me Except those above named
the remaining half shall be Equally divided betwixt my loving wife
Mary Jordan and my daughter Sarah each having an equal part And
as for my horses Cattle Sheep & Hogs I will that my Son Joseph have the
half of them & the remaining half to be Equally divided betwixt my
wife Mary & my two daughters Margaret & Sarah Each of them having
an equal part And I will that these negroes & horses be divided according
to quantity and quality If my wife shall see proper to marry
I will that she possess none of my Estate Either Real or Personal
Except a Negro Wench Horse & Saddle and who ever of my Children
dies without leaving Lawfull heirs whatever Estate they have from
me shall return to the surviving heirs of the rest of my children I will

That my Son Joseph and my Wife Mary Jerdon be executors of my Estate and
do hereby revoke and make void all former Wills & Testaments by me
heretofore made in this place whereof the said Abram Jerdon have pronounced
Set my hand & Seal this 11th day of December the Year of our Lord One
thousand Seven hundred & fifty eight.

Give devise and bequeath the same in manner and form following
That is to say Imprimis I Give and Bequeath unto the Vestry
and Church Wardens of the aforesaid Parish of Saint John and their
Successors the sum of fifty pounds Current money to be placed out at
Interest for the Benefit of the Poor of the said Parish Item I Give and
Bequeath unto my Brother Nathaniel Broughton and to his Heirs forever
four Negro slaves named old Sappi, Sam Young Jones and Anthony
Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Brother Alexander Broughton & to
his Heirs for ever one Negro slave named Young Simon Item it is my
will that my Sister Charlotte Izard shall take her Choice of a young
Negro woman Slave out of the Remainder of my Slaves which said
woman Slave together with my Riding Chair and Chair Horse I Give
bequeath unto my Said Sister Charlotte Izard and to her heirs for ever
Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Niece Charlotte Broughton daugh-
ter of my Brother Nathaniel Broughton and to her heirs for ever my dia-
mond Ear Rings Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Niece
Mary Broughton daughter of my Brother Alexander Broughton and to her
heirs for ever my diamond Rose Ring Item I Give and Bequeath unto my
Niece Charlotte Broughton also daughter to my Brother Alexander Broughton
& to her heirs for ever Item my green Stone Ring with two diamond parts
Item all the rest of my Jewels I Give & Bequeath unto my Sister Charlotte
Izard & to her heirs forever Item all the rest and Residue of my Estate of what
nature and kind soever and wheresoever I Give devised & Bequeath unto my said
