

In the name of God Amen, I Alexander Urquhart, Master of the Sloop, *Delaney* now lying in the Harbour of Charlestown in the Province of South Carolina being in good health of Body, and of a sound and disposing mind and memory, (for which I bless God) Do this Twentieth day of December in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty nine, make and ordain this my last Will and Testaments in manner and form following that is to say, I give, devise and bequeath all my Estate real and personal unto my loving Wife Martha, her Heirs, Executors Administrators and assigns for ever, And do Nominate, Constitute and Appoint my said Wife Martha Executrix, and Benjamin Young, and Charles Ogilvie of Charlestown aforesaid Gentlemen, Executors of this my Last Will and Testament hereby Revoking and making null and Void, all former and other wills, by me at any time heretofore made. In witness whereof, I have hereunto sett my hand and seal, at Charlestown aforesaid, the day and Year above written.
