

We it known to all Men by these presents That I Thomas Affleck of
Prince William Parish Merchant have made & declared my Last Will &
Testament in Writing bearing date the eighteenth day of January 1750
The said Thomas Affleck by this Present do Ratify and Confirm my
Last will & Testament & do Give & bequeath before my Estate be divided
my Loving Aunt Magdalen Ward Twenty Pound Sterling & also to my
friend Thomas Ballantine four Guineas to be paid them by my Executors
And my Meaning is that this Codicil be adjudged to be a part of my Last
Will and Testament and that all things therein mentioned be faithfully and
truly performed as fully in every respect as if the same were so declared & set
down in my Last Will & Testament Witness my hand this Sixth day of Feb^r
1758

This will & Codicil was proved and at the same Thomas Affleck
Time John Edwards qualified as Executor

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Hodson of St Andrews Parish and
Province of South Carolina Planter being in a bad State of health but of sound
memory thanks be to almighty God for the same and knowing their is a time
for all men to die do hereby make this my Last Will & Testament believing
in Christ Jesus I bequeath my soul to God who gave it and all my Estate that
it hath pleased God to bless me with I will and bequeath in manner following
that is to say First I Will and desire my body may be Interred in a decent
manner and my Just Debt be fully paid and satisfied I will and bequeath
to my Dear and well beloved wife Mary Hodson half a dozen Cambridge
Chairs four head of horses and mares one Mahogany Table one Negro Man
named Joe one Negro woman named Bess and one Negro Girl named
Hannah as also one Desk one Bedstead Bed and furniture one Bedding
Trunk one Cyprus Table one Poplar Table one Tea Kettle three Boxes &
two Cows & Calves to hold the same to her and her heirs for ever
Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Herbert Hodson one good a ball and
one Mare called Rose to him and his heirs for ever Item I Give and
bequeath to my daughter Sarah Hodson one Negro Woman named Dot
with two cows & calves and one feather Bed and furniture to hold the same
to her and her heirs for ever Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Thomas
Hodson all and Every the Remaining part of my Estate both real & personal
wheresoever it may be found to him and his heirs for ever he
said Thomas Hodson allowing out of the same the sum of One
hundred and fifty Pound current Money of South Carolina to be paid
to my daughter Mary Hodson when she may Arrive to the of Twenty
years if demanded and it is my farther will that my wife Mary Hodson
may have the Liberty of Living on my Said Plantation untill such time
as my Son Thomas shall Arrive to the age of Twenty one years Item
It is my will that all my Estate may be disposed of after the manner
as I heretofore mentioned and that there be no Publick Sale made thereof
and that my Son Thomas Hodson and my friend Robert Wood to be my true
and Lawfull Executors of this my Last will and Testament before
revoking and disannulling all other wills and Testaments by me made

In the Name of God Amen The second day of April in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and fifty eight I Lewis Linder of Workley County in the Province of South Carolina Planter being very sick and weak in body but perfect of mind and memory / Thanks be to God and calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all Men Once to die do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament That is to say Principally and first of all I Give and Recommend my Soul to God that gave it, and my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian Like and decent Manner at the discretion of my Executors herein after named and as touching Such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I Give devise and dispose of the same in manner and form following That is to say I Give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife Mary Magdalene One third Part of all and singular my Estate also the Cash or Monies in hand which I shall be possessed of at the time of my death to her only proper Use and Behoof to herself her heirs and Assigns for ever, Item I Give Devise and bequeath unto my beloved son Daniel Linder my Dwelling House and other Buildings and out Houses adjoining thereto with three Hundred Acres of Land first surveyed at the settling of the said Plantation to himself his heirs and Assigns for ever Item I Give Devise and bequeath unto my beloved two Sons Lewis and Jacob that other Tract of Land containing Four hundred Acres together with the Mill erected thereon and all the Appurtenances thereunto belonging to themselves their Heirs and Assigns for ever Item I Give and bequeath unto my above named three Sons Daniel Lewis and Jacob and unto my four Daughters Mary Elizabeth Margaret and Katherine all the Remainder of my Moveable Effects Equally all to the themselves their Heirs and Assigns for ever And Lastly I do make constitute and appoint my said beloved wife Mary Magdalene and my said son Daniel and my son in Law William Young to be the Executors of this my Last Will and Testament And Guardians of so many of my Children as are under Age until they be of Age And I do hereby utterly Disallow Revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills and Legacies Bequests and Executors by me in any ways before this Time made and Bequeathed, ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my Last will and Testament In Witnes whereof I have herunto Set my hand
