

Slaves to my daughters and as my Grandson Thomas Haggard ²³ has been divided I do hereby certify my Intention satisfaction concerning all things and give to such such Slaves as they now have in their possession so as the remaining part my Estate may be Intirely divided as follows I give and bequeath unto my Great Grandson Thomas Junior Two Slaves one named Molly and the other named Paquito to him and his heirs for ever I do give and bequeath unto and to be equally divided in families by Lot among my Children Grand Children & Great Grand Children to wit William, Mary and Sarah Haggard Great Grand Children Elizabeth Harvey daughter Haggard and Thomas Harvey Grand Children Mary Wigg daughter William Haggard Wigg Sarah Wigg Ann Mary and Eleanor Wigg Grand Children all my Slaves Stock of all kinds Household Goods Plantation Tools and credits the whole Personal Estate to be equally divided among all the above mentioned daughters Grand Children & Great Grand Children above named to them and their heirs for ever I do nominate and appoint my friends Nathaniel Barnwell John Barnwell William Harvey Esq. William Haggard my Executors to this my last Will and Testament attonly Revoking and Disannulling all other Wills heretofore made acknowledging this only ^{Witness}

This Indict made January the 29 Anno 1757 Witnesseth to all Persons whom it may concern that Whereas it hath pleased Almighty God to take to himself my dear and well beloved Grandson Thomas Harvey by which the said bequeathed to him has fallen to me in Reversion and whereas my well beloved daughter Elizabeth Harvey is now Pregnant and Great with Child Therefore by these Presents give the Moiety or half Part the said I thought of Mr. Thomas Barnmaster to the said Infant now in the Womb as also an equal share of my Slaves and Moveable Estate with my other Children Grand Children and Great Grand Children mentioned in this my last Will and Testament the said Moiety and half Part the said Land and share of Slaves and moveables to the said Infant my daughter Harvey is now big with and to its heirs forever

In the Name of God Amen I Anthony Bonneau Sen. of Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina Planter being in good health sound and disposing mind and Memory blessed be God for the same Do make & Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following First and Principally I commend my soul into the hand of Almighty God hoping through the satisfaction and Merits of my only Saviour and Dear Redeemer Jesus Christ to have full and free Pardon of all my sins

34 and to Inherit Eternal Life my body I commit to the Earth to be
decently Buried at the discretion of my Executors & Executors here-
after named and touching such Temporal Estate as it hath Pleased
God of his Infinite Mercy to bestow upon me I Give and dispose thereof as
followeth: I Pray that all my Just debts and funeral Charges
and Expenses be first paid and discharged Item I Give and bequeath
unto my Loving wife Margaret Henriette the Sum of two thousand
Pounds Current Money of South Carolina to be paid her one year after
my decease also I Give unto my said wife two Negroes at her Election
out of my Slaves the use of two Rooms in my house at her Election
(during my Widow) All her wearing Apparel the Bed whereon We lay
with all its furniture a Linen Dress Six Chairs a Table a Looking
Glass a good Horn a side table half dozen Silver Chubb & Tea spoons
and her Riding Chair to her and her heirs forever But I do hereby declare
that the several Legacies gifts and Devises by me herein bequeathed
unto my said Wife are so given unto her and are meant and Intended
to be in full Satisfaction and Bar of all such Dower and Title of Dower
and Interest and customary Part share or thirds of my Real & Personal
Estate which she or may claim by any Right or Title or custom
whatsoever Item if any of my Children to whom is hereafter hereingiven
and devised should dye before they come to Age to Inherit and have
no issue then I Order that their share or Part given and bequeathed them
real or Personal to be Equally divided or Shared amongst my Surviving
Children Item I Give devise and bequeath unto my Son Anthony the
Plantation whereon I now live which I Purchased of M^r Samuel Dowe
containing together four hundred acres of Land as also one Tract which
I Purchased of M^r Robert Daniel containing five hundred & Ninety
acres of Land, one Tract which I purchased of M^r Joseph Wamock
Containing two hundred and fifty acres of Land and an other Tract which
I lately purchased of M^r John Seferne (adjoining each other) with all
thereunto belonging containing together in the whole sixteen hundred
and forty acres of Land to have and to hold the said Tract of four hundred
Acres, the Tract of five hundred and Ninety acres the Tract of Two
hundred and fifty acres and the Tract Purchased of M^r John Seferne
Containing about Four hundred acres of Land to my said Son Anthony
his heirs and assigns for ever Item I Give devise and bequeath unto
my hereafter named Executors and Executors part of three Tracts of Land
Containing together Six hundred and Ninety acres where I formerly lived
which was given me by my late father with all thereunto belonging to
have and to hold the said part of three Tracts of Land containing
together Six hundred and Ninety acres to my hereafter named Executors
& Executors to them and their heirs for ever upon Trust that they shall
sell and dispose of the Same and the Moneys arising on the Same to
be Equally divided amongst my Children or the Survivors of them
Item I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Margaret Henriette
Ashby one Negro Wench named Phillis with all her issue & Increase
one Girl named Lucy with her after Increase and one Negro Man

Named Oxford to her and her heirs for ever (and which are now in her
 Possession) Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary One
 Negro Wench named Mary with her two Children Tommy & Hannah
 and one Girl named Catoe with their Issue and Increase & half
 dozen Table & Tea Silver spoons Item I give and bequeath unto my
 daughter Catherine One Negro Wench named Hannah with her child
 Satoe one Girl named Floe with their Issue and Increase and half dozen
 & Tea spoons Item I give and bequeath unto my son Anthony one Negro
 boy named Cesar, my Knife Barrell Gun my Silver hilted Sword & Boucane
 my Silver watch and half Dozen silver Table and Tea spoons Item
 Whereas I have made use of eight hundred Pounds Current Money
 belonging to my daughter Mary being Part of the Legacy left her by her late
 Uncle Peter Horry deceased, my Will is that she shall be paid the said Sum
 of eight hundred pounds out of my Estate and to have her equal share
 of my Personal Estate with the Rest of my Children Item I give full Power
 and Authority to my hereafter named Executors & Executors to sell & dispose
 of all or any part of my Personal Estate which is not hereingiven or
 Bequeathed when ever they shall think proper and the Monies arising
 thereon to be put to Interest with Security for my Children and to Pay their
 Shares to each of them as they shall attain their age to Inherit or day of
 Marriage to wit my son Anthony and my three daughters Margaret Henrietta
 Ashby Mary and Catherine Bonneau, to them and their heirs forever
 Item in case my said Wife should have any more Children by me after the
 signing of the presents that then the Child or Children so born shall have
 the equal Portion with the rest of my above Children, Item I do hereby
 Nominate and Appoint my said Loving Wife Margaret Henrietta Bonneau
 of this my last will and Testament so long as she shall continue my Widow
 and no longer and my Brother Benjamin Bonneau my two Brothers in
 Law Daniel Horry and Paul Traquier Esq. Executors of this my last Will
 and Testament hereby Revoking and making null and void all former and
 other Will and Wills by me heretofore made and this to be and stand as and
 for my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said Anthony
 Bonneau Sen. have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand & Seal
 this Twentieth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred
