following That is to say First I will That all my Just debt be duly paid & Settled
Them I Give devise & bequeath unto my son Thomas Scott & to his heirs for
Ever all that Plantation or Tract of Land containing two hundred & thirteen
Acres on Ashley River lately Purchased from Charles Jones Subject never the less
to the Payment of Six hundred pounds Curr Money to my son William Scott
within One Year after deceased By the said Thomas Scott his heir or assigns
Them I Give unto my wife Agnes Scott the Use of all my Land & Plantations
on James Island for the Term of seven & a half years from the date of the
Long remains my widow unmarried to the Intent that my Children during
their Minority be supported & maintained out of the Rents Issues & profits
of the same Them I Give devise & bequeath unto my son David One hundred Acres
of Land being the place I now Live upon when and as he shall attain the Age
of Twenty one years to hold to him his heirs & assigns for Ever Them I Give devise
& bequeath unto son John when & as he shall attain the Age of Twenty One
years all that my plantation called Carlisle forgoing the plantation
where I now live to hold to him his heirs & assigns for Ever which two
plantations I will that each be Chargeable & Payable to the Payment of
Two hundred pounds Currency a piece unto Thomas, William & Archib.
Scott or their Legal Representatives that is to say each plantation Char-
geable for payment of Six hundred pounds Currency Immediately
Upon the devisees Entry upon the same and if the said David or John shall
happen to die before the said age of Twenty One years the Plantation
intended for him so dying I Give devise to the survivor of them & his heirs
for Ever Chargeable with the payment of Six hundred pounds as aforesaid
Them I will that in case my Wife marries Again That she have the Use
of the House where I now dwell with ^{land & house} ten Acres of Carlisle plantation
& forgoing the other ten Acres with the Use of the Barn & all the other Build-
ings with sufficient fencing & firewood during the Term of her Natural life
Them I Give to my son Archibald Scott One Negro boy named Sambo
my Gold Sleeve buttons and Six hundred pounds Currency to be raised
out of my Personall Estate Them I Give to my son William Scott One

173/ Negroe Boy boy named Sampson, Item I give unto my daughters Ann
and Jane Scott the Sum of Six Hundred pound Currency Each to be deliv-
er'd them with the Interest Arising thereon at the age of Eighteen Years respec-
tively or day of Marriage which may first happen for which purpose I
will that twelve hundred pound be let out at Interest on good Security within
twelve Months after my decease And if either of my said Daughters shall
happen to die before the said Age or Marriage the Legacy intended for such
Daughter so dying shall go to the Survivor to be delivered as aforesaid I give
to my Daughter Ann Philadelphia, Kate with her Issue & Increase Item
I give to my Daughter Jane a Negroe Girl named Flora with her Issue
& Increase Item I give to my son John a Negroe Girl named Judey with
her Issue and Increase Item I give unto my son David a Negroe Boy (also
Joe of young Rodger) I give unto my aforesaid wife One Bed & furniture
the best in the House she to have her Choice the best horse or mare -
she may chuse out on the Plantation with the riding chair, Also my
also my Negroe Man by Roger and Hannah his Wife with the heir
future Issue & Increase and I give my said wife Liberty to cut & clear
Twenty Acres of Land of the Plantation where she may think it most
convenient for her use to Till & Labour on during her Widowhood I
hereby confirm the gift I lately made my son Thomas of a Negroe slave
named Will And all the rest residue & remainder of my Estate not
herein before given or devised I will be allotted & divided into eight equal
parts or shares one Eighth part or share whereof I give unto my said
wife Agnes Scott One other Eighth part or share I give to my son Thomas
Scott one other Eighth part or share to my son William, One other Eighth
part or share to my son Archibald, One other Eighth part to my Daughter
Ann one other Eighth part to my Daughter Jane One other Eighth part to my
son David & one other Eighth part being the residue to my son John to be
delivered my said sons at the age of Twenty one years or day of Marriage
& my Daughters at the age of Eighteen years or day of Marriage which may
first happen And I hereby nominate & appoint my said wife Agnes Scott
Executrix my son Thomas Scott & friend John Remington Executors
of this my Last Will & Testament hereby revoking all former & other wills
by me at any time heretofore made declaring this Only to be my Last Will
& Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal to
this & one other sheet of Paper here to Annexed both which together con-
tain my said will the Twelfth day of May In the year of our Lord One
Thous and Seven hundred & fifty seven
