This will was proved before the Ordinary the Sixteenth day of
February 1759 at the same time I qualified Nathaniel Broughton
and Alexander Broughton Executors to the same

In the name of God Amen I Charles McLane of Granville County in the
Province of South Carolina Planter being Informed of my body but of sound
and disposing mind & memory praised be to God therefore do make and
ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following
That is to say first I Recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty
God who gave it and my body to the Earth to be decently Buried at the
Discretion of my Executors aforesaid and as for my concerning all
such worldly goods and Estate that it hath pleased god to bless me with I
give devise and bequeath as follows Item first my is that all my Due
full debts repaid out of my Estate Item I give and Bequeath to my Beloved
Friend William Bowrey one hundred and fifty pounds to him and his heirs
for ever I also give and Bequeath to my beloved Friend Anne Bowrey
the sum of one hundred & fifty pounds to her and her heirs for ever
Item I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Friend Susanah Bowrey one
bright Day more to have & to hold for ever Item I give and bequeath
to my beloved Friend Joseph Bowrey in one Dun Rose to have and to hold
for ever Item I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Friend Joseph Bowrey
gent one black Mare to him and his heirs for ever Item I give and beq
to my Beloved Brother Allen McLane after all my Lawfull debts and
legacies as paid of as above mentioned all my Real Estate and Personal
Estate to him and his Heirs for ever Lastly I do likewise constitute &
Appoint my Beloved Brother Allen McLane and my Beloved Friend Joseph
Bowrey as my true and Lawfull executors to this my last Will and Testament
and I do hereby Revise and make void all former and other wills by me
at any time heretofore made and do make and Ordain this present
and none other to be and contain this my only last Will and Testament
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 25 day of

January 1755
