Personal Estate as they shall arrive to the age of twenty one years &
my daughter to have her proportion or part when she arrives to these
Age or day of Marriage which shall happen first and in case either of
my said children should die under the age aforesaid that then and in
such case my surviving children to Inherit their Brother or sister
Part. Item I do hereby appoint my Friends Mr Francis Sejan Jun
& Mr Ashby to be my Executors and Guardians to my four children
Peter, Robert, John and Elizabeth Sallens untill they arrive to the
age of 21. Resolving and making Void all other Wills & Confirming

honour and Redeemer in whom and by whose merits I trust and believe
a joyful resurrection and to have full remission and forgiveness for all
my sins and to Inherit the Kingdom of Heaven and my Body I
Commit to the earth to be decently buried by my husband William M.

And for the settling of my Temporal Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow
upon me I do Order and Dispose the same in manner and form following
that is to say. Inprimis I give devise and bequeath unto my Son
William Moses the Money arising from the Wanch that he is sold for
to be put at Interest for him until he shall attain the Age of twenty one
Item I give devise and bequeath the Money that the boy Jamey is sold
for unto my husband William Moses. Item I give Devise and bequeath the
Money that the boy Jacob is sold for unto my Mother. And Thereby
make and appoint my Brother John Guinn and M. John Barnwell
full and sole Executors and Trustees to my Son of this my last Will and
Testament hereby Revoking disannulling and making void all former
Wills and Bequests by me made and Declaring this to be my last Will

Negro woman Named Daphne together with her issue and increase also my
Diamond Ring and Pearl Necklace, Item I give and bequeath unto my well
beloved Son Robert Taylor one Negro girl named Peggy together with her issue
and increase also my Wedding Ring Silver tooth picker Case and Silver Buttons
and six Silver Soup spoons. Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved
Daughter Katherine Taylor One Tract containing five hundred Acres of Land
situate in the Place commonly known by the name of the Halfway Swamp together with
one Lot within the limits of Charles Town in a Street leading from Third Street to
Anchley River To have and to hold the Tract of five hundred Acres of Land
and Town Lot as aforesaid to her the said Katherine Taylor her heirs & assigns
forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my two well beloved Children Katherine
