I will that all my Lawfull debts and funeral Charges be paid Item I give unto
my Nephew John McPherson the Sum of two thousand pounds to be paid him
by my Executors as they shall see proper to him and his heirs Item I give unto
my Nephew William McPherson and my Sister Margaret Hamilton and my
Niece Isabella Baxter in case no Relation of my deceased Husband should
appear it is my Will and desire that all my Estate should be Equally divided
among the above, and it is my desire if any Lawfull Relation of deceased
Husband should appear before the time of my Nephew William McPherson
should come to age of Twenty one years he or she should have the same
part of my Estate as the above it is my will that all the Silver Plate and
fish and half of my household Goods with half of my wearing Cloaths to
be given my Niece Isabella Baxter and the other half of my Household
Goods with half of my Cloaths to be given to my Sister Margaret Hamilton
And it is my desire that my brother John Baxter to have all my Husband's
Cloaths and it is my Will that all the Obligations that I have of my
Brothers to be given up to him at my death and one Silver Watch named
Satch to be given to my said Brother and a silver watch named the
man to be given to William McPherson and it is my Will that no division
to be made of my Estate untill that my Nephew William McPherson
shall come of age as above, it is my desire that my Sister Margaret
should have my Riding Colair and Horse called slowing and Davis
that one hundred Pound to be given to Mrs. Susanna Payton out of my
Sisters Part and one hundred pounds to be given to Mrs. Elizabeth Edwards
out of my Nephew Williams Part when there is a division made of my
Estate Lastly I do constitute make and appoint my beloved Friends my
Executors, John Mc. Queen Robert Philp Hugh House William

McPherson of this my last Will and Testament I do
disannulling void all former and other Wills and Testaments
whenever heretofore made and done Ratifying and hereby Revoking
other to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have
