In the name of God amen I Isaac Guerin of the parish of St Thomas and St Dennis in Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina planter being of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God and knowing the uncertainty of this life do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following that is to say, First and principally I commend my Soul into the hands of almighty God hoping through the merits Death and passion of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ to have full & free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins, and to inherit Eternal life, and my Body I commit to the Earth to be Buried at the discretion of my Exors hereafter named and concerning the disposition of all such Temporall Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bestow upon me, I dispose therefore as follows the Item is my will that all my Will that all my Just Debts and funerals charges be first paid and discharged, Item I give and Bequeath unto my loving wife Martha the choice of one of my Negroe wenches that shall belong to my Estate at the time of my Decease, also the choice

of one of my Horses and aside Saddle, a Feather Bed, Bolster two Pillows and also
pair of Sheets, and three Blankets, and a Bedstead and one Chest of Drawers
to her and her Heirs and assigns forever, and also the liberty to live in my
House During the time she remains my Widow and no longer, Item I give
unto my sons Robert and Sam^l. all that Plantation or Tract of Land whereon I
now live containing ~~the~~ hundred acres or thereabouts to be Equally divided
amongst them, their Heirs and assigns forever, my will is that my son Sam^l
shall have his part on that place where the Buildings are, wherein I now
live, and in case any one of my said two Sons Robert or Samuel should die
before they attain their full age of Twenty one years then my will is that the
Survivor of them shall have the part of Land of him so dying, Item I give &
Bequeath unto my Daughter Esther, one Negroe wench named Phillis together
with her future issue and Increase to her and her Heirs and assigns forever to be
Delivered to her at the day of Marriage or the age of Twenty one Years the which
shall first happen, and in case the said Negroe wench named Phillis should die before
she shall be in possession of my said Daughter at the time aforesaid, then my will is
that my said Daughter Esther shall have another Negroe wench Bought for her
out of my Personall Estate in lieu of the one so dying, Item I give and Bequeath
unto my son Sam^l one Negroe girl named Molly together with her issue & Increase
to him and his Heirs and assigns forever to be Delivered to him at the age of Twenty
one years and in case the said Negroe girl named Molly should die before she
shall be in possession of my said son at the time aforesaid then my will is that
my said son Samuel shall have another girl Bought for him out of my Personall
Estate in lieu of the one so dying Item it is my will that my son Samuel should have
his Maintenance and Education out of the Income profit or produce of my Estate until
his respective age of Twenty one years I make the rest and residuum of my Estate
which is not herein given I my will is that it shall be Equally divided into Lots
amongst my said wife and Children, Item Robert Sam^l and my Daughter Esther
to them and their Heirs and assigns forever, But in case any of my said Children
should die Before their respective ages of Twenty one years or times aforesaid
Then I give Devise or Bequeath the Share or Shares of him, her or them
so dying of the personall part to be Equally divided between my said wife and
Children to them and their Heirs and assigns forever, and lastly I do hereby
Nominate and appoint my said wife Martha ~~Ex^{or}~~ and my said Sons Henry
and Robert Exors of this my last will hereby making and making
and void all wills by me heretofore made, and this only to be my Will and
Testament In Witnes whereof the said Isaac Guerin hath to this
