understanding thanks be to Almighty God do make Publish and declare  
this my last will and Testament in manner and form following has  
is to say, Imprimis, I will order and direct that all my just debts and sure  
ral expences be first paid by my Executrix and Executors herein after mentioned  
Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Nicholes Six  
Negro Slaves by name Quamina, Sue Miley and her three Children  
Minta Rachell and Nance together with their Increase to her and her  
Heirs for ever. Also, I give and bequeath unto my said Daughter Elizabeth  
Nicholes Three Thousand Pounds Current Money of the Province  
aforesaid to be paid her out of my Estate when she arrives to the age of  
Eighteen years or day of marriage which shall first happen after my  
Decease, I further will order and direct that my said Daughter Elizabeth  
Nichols be Educated and maintained out of my Estate at the discretion  
of my Executrix and Executors till she arrives at the age of eighteen  
years or day of marriage as aforesaid, Item I give and bequeath unto  
my beloved Sister Ruth Bedon Two Negro Women slaves now in her Posses-  
sion by name Sall and Venus with their Increase to her and her heirs  
for ever also I give and bequeath unto my said Sister Ruth Bedon three  
Thousand Pounds Current Money of the Province aforesaid to be paid her by  
my Executrix and Executors within twelve months after my decease in view  
of all Rights Titles or demand whatsoever she may or can have upon my  
Estate and in case my said Sister Ruth Bedon shall sue or cause to  
be sued for any other of my Estate and do Recover the same then the said  
Three thousand Pounds to go towards Payment of what she shall or may  
recover against my Estate Item I will order and direct that my executors  
do build for my said wife Elizabeth Nicholes a proper and decent House  
with all other necessary out houses on any part of my Plantation that  
she or they shall judge most convenient and that the expences of the  
same be paid out of the profits arising from my Estate, Item I give and  
bequeath and Devise unto my beloved Sons James Nicholes and Henry  
Nicholes all my Land to be equally divided between them when they shall  
arrive to the age of twenty one years to them and their heirs for ever and  
whereas my said wife Elizabeth Nicholes is now with child and in law  
the said child prove a male, I do hereby Authorize and Impower my  
Executrix and Executors to buy a Plantation or Tract of Land within  
equal to the value of the half of the land I went to my said Sons James  
and Henry and that the purchase money be paid out of the profits arising  
from my Estate before division be made and in case of the death of  
either of my Sons before they arrive to twenty one years all the land  
are to be divided amongst the surviving males to them and their heirs  
for ever Item I give and bequeath to my said wife Elizabeth Nicholes  
my said Sons James Nicholes and Henry Nicholes and to the Child which  
my wife is now bearing with all and singular the residue of my Estate what  
ever that is not already dispersed of consisting of Negroes money at Inter-

19<sup>th</sup> or otherwise, Horses Cattle Sheep Hogs House hold Furniture  
plate &c that I now are possessed of to be equally divided amongst them  
share and share alike to them and their heirs for ever leaving it in the  
Power of my said Wife Elizabeth Nichols to choose Six Negroes to be  
Included in her Deed and share or my Personal Estates Item I do have  
by Authority and Impower my Executor and Executrix herein after  
mentioned to buy sell and dispose of all and Singular the Profts & Losses  
from my Estate over and above what is before Willed and given away for  
the Benefit of my wife and Children And Lastly I do hereby nominate  
Constitute and Appoint my Loving wife Elizabeth Nichols Executrix and my  
Loving Friends James Bullock Sarah Corp Archibald Stangarne &  
Algernoon Wilson Executrix of this my Last Last Will and Testament hereby  
Revoking and Chaking void all former and other Wills heretofore made by  
me declaring these presents to be and Contain my Last Will and Testament  
Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seal the fifth day  
of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and  
fifty nine

things do make and Ordain in these presents following to be and  
to contain my Last Will and Testament First I recommend  
my soul into the hands of God hoping for Pardon and Remission of our  
Lord Jesus Christ and as for what Worldly Estate it has pleased God  
to bestow upon me Give and dispose of in the following manner Item I  
give and devise and bequeath after my just debts are paid unto Elizabeth  
Glancy the wife of Richard Glancy deceased the sum of fifty pound  
Currency of the Province aforesaid to be paid to her by my Execr hereafter  
named Item I give and devise and bequeath unto Richard Singelton the  
son of Daniel Singelton half my Estate and to his heirs for ever —  
Item I give and devise and bequeath the other half of my Estate  
unto Mary Grange now the wife of Hugh Grange with the proviso she  
pays all my lawfull debts But in case the said Mary Grange should  
die without issue of the said Hugh Grange then her part of the said  
Estate to be divided to the said Richard Singelton the son of Daniel  
Singelton and to his heirs for ever And I hereby nominate Richard and
